(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (B6165 AND TOWN STREET, NIDD) **ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 26 June 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified below in Schedule 1 and to revoke 'North Yorkshire County Council (40 mph Speed Limit) (B6165 and Town Street, Nidd) Order 2021' in so far as it relates to Schedule 1, item 2 as detailed in Schedule 2 below :-
