(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(AMENDMENT NO 38) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 26 June 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Ryedale) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

1.	Main Street	Both	From its junction with the A170, Weasdale to Partings Farm, to a point 52 metres south of the centre line of its junction with Church Lane.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 06 July 2026, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Pickering Library, The Ropery, Pickering, YO18 8DY during normal office hours from 01 July 2026 to 07 August 2026 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 26 June 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
