(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(VARIOUS ROADS, COLBURN) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 03 July 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to introduce the restrictions specified in the Schedule below:-

Colburn	Bailey Court	West	Its junction with Chartermark Way	A point 12 metres north of its junction with Chartermark Way (measured along the western kerbline)	No Waiting At Any Time
Colburn	Bailey Court	East	Its junction with Chartermark Way	A point 12 metres north of its junction with Chartermark Way (measured along the eastern kerbline)	No Waiting At Any Time
Colburn	Chartermark Way	North East	Its junction with the east side of Bailey Court	Its junction with the north side of Battalion Court	No Waiting At Any Time
Colburn	Battalion Court	North	Its junction with Chartermark Way	A point 13 metres east of its junction with Chartermark Way (measured along the northern kerbline)	No Waiting At Any Time
Colburn	Battalion Court	South	Its junction with Chartermark Way	A point 13 metres east of its junction with Chartermark Way (measured along the southern kerbline)	No Waiting At Any Time
Colburn	Chartermark Way	East	Its junction with the south side of Battalion Court	A point 9 metres south of its junction with the south side of Battalion Court	No Waiting At Any Time

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 03 July 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
