(20 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) **(VARIOUS ROADS, GRANTLEY)** **ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 24 July 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour and 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

Part 1

ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF GRANTLEY

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Bountin Hill to Broadfield Lane (U2966)	From its junction with the C31 (Grantley Village) in a westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres.
2.	Bountin Hill to Upper Holburn Bridge (C31)	From its junction with the U2966 in a northerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.
3.	Grantley to Low Grantley (U2968)	For its entirety.
4.	Grantley Village (C31/U2969)	For its entirety.
5.	High Grantley to Heatherlands (U2969)	From its junction with the U2970 in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 273 metres.
6.	High Grantley to Sewerage works (U2970)	For its entirety.
7.	High Grantley to Grantley Hall (C31)	From its junction with Grantley Village for a distance of approximately 58 metres in a south easterly direction

1.	Bountin Hill to Upper Holburn Bridge (C31)	From a point 20 metres north of its junction with the U2966 in a northerly direction to a point 15 metres north of its junction with the U2946
2.	Ruddings Plantation to Low Grantley (U2946)	From its junction with the C31 in an easterly direction to its junction with the U2752

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 24 July 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
