PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2011 (AMENDMENT NO 117) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 21 July 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Scarborough) Consolidation Order 2011” by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedule below:-

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING

Location	Road	Side	From	To	Nature of Restriction
Scarborough	Caxton Way	Southeast	a point 11 metres south of the termination point of Claxton Way	for a distance of 190 metres in a generally southerly then south easterly direction	No waiting at any time.
Scarborough	Caxton Way	Northeast	a point 30 metres south of the termination point of Claxton Way	for a distance of 287 metres in a generally south easterly and then northerly direction onto Thornburgh Road.	No waiting at any time.
Scarborough	Thornburgh Road	East	a point 287 metres North of the centre of the junction of Great Hill	for a distance of 39 metres in a Northernly direction	No waiting at any time.
Scarborough	Thornburgh Road	East	a point 336 metres North of the centre of the junction of Great Hill	for a distance of 59 metres in a generally Northernly direction	No waiting at any time.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 03 August 2026, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Scarborough Library & Information Centre, Vernon Road, Scarborough YO11 2NN during normal office hours from 30 July 2026 to 01 September 2026 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 21 July 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
