Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1)
(as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpath, 35.72/1/1 in the Parish of West Haddlesey, between grid references SE57042742 and SE56702714 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 10th August 2026 and 19th January 2027 due to an unsafe bridge.

This Order follows Emergency Notice No 150.

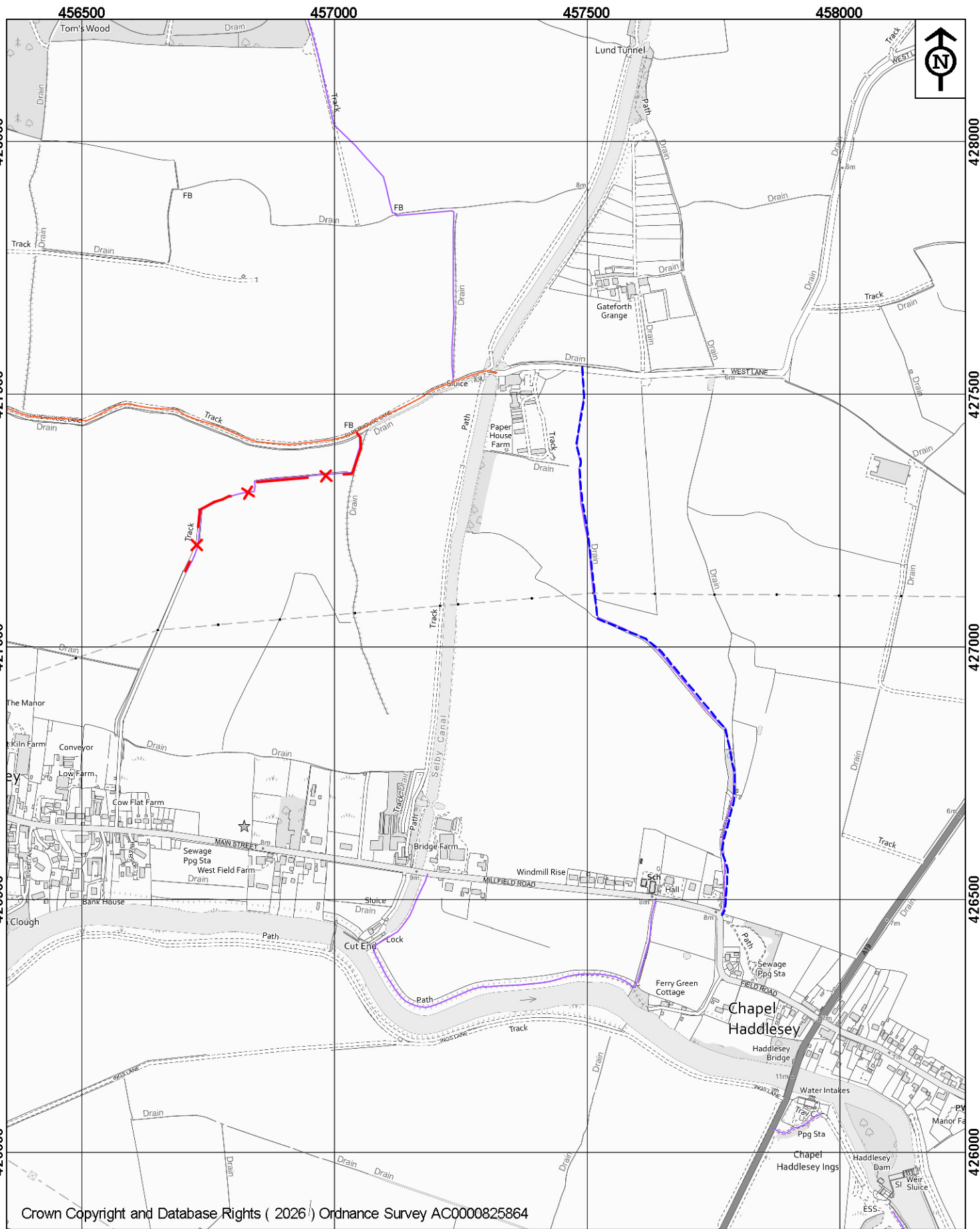
The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
