

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(20, 30, 40 & 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) **(VARIOUS ROADS, BROMPTON)** **ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour, 30 miles per hour, 40 miles per hour and 50 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 to Schedule 4 below. The orders specified in Column 1 in Schedule 5 are to be revoked in respect of the extents shown in Column 2 of said Schedule: -

6.	Danes Crest	For its entirety.
7.	Fullicar Lane	From its junction with Water End in a north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 51 metres.
8.	Lead Lane	From a point approximately 67 metres north west of its junction with Stokesley Road in a north westerly direction to its junction with Cockpit Hill
9.	Little Lane	From a point approximately 44 metres north west of its junction with Stokesley Road in a north westerly direction to its junction with Water End
10.	Linen Way	For its entirety.
11.	Northallerton Road	From its junction with Station Road in a south westerly direction to a point approximately 15 metres north east of its intersection with the projected north eastern kerbline of Mill Hill Close
12.	Orchard Grove	For its entirety.
13.	Station Road	For its entirety.
14.	The Green	For its entirety.
15.	Water End	For its entirety.

3.	Stokesley Road	From a point approximately 236 metres north east of its junction with the projected north eastern kerbline of North Moor Road in a north easterly direction to a point approximately 215 metres north east of its intersection with the projected north eastern kerbline of Little Lane
