(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(AMENDMENT NO 81) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 18th August 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Selby) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the schedule below:-

WAITING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES WITH EXEMPTIONS

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 31st August 2026, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Selby Library, 52 Micklegate, Selby, YO8 4EQ during normal office hours from 27th August 2026 to 29th September 2026 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 18th August 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
