NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 35.59/11 & 35.57/31, THE GRANARY, SOUTH MILFORD, DIVERSION ORDER 2026

On 17 July 2026, The North Yorkshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the Public Footpath as described below.

Public Footpath No. 35.59/11 and 35.57/31 between grid reference 44912 43165 and 44920 43191 will be diverted onto a new route alignment.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Sherburn & Villages Community Library, Finkle Hill, Sherburn-in-Elmet, North Yorkshire until 24 September 2026. Copies of the Order and Map may be purchased from the Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices.

The Order comes into force on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, described in part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 13 August 2026, make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the Public Footpath described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Margaret and Matthew Burden, The Granary, Mill Lane, South Milford, LS25 5AG have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

South Milford Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

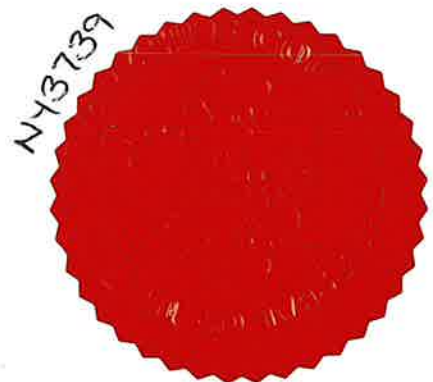
BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at The Granary, South Milford and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 120 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a Public Footpath over the land situated at The Granary, South Milford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the schedule: install a new footbridge at Point E with pedestrian gates at either end, install a pedestrian gate at Point F and install a ramp between Points F and G.

Public Footpath No. 35.57/31 marked by a bold continuous line and shown as C-D on the attached plan.	From Grid Reference 44914 43179 (Point C) runs in a generally north east direction for approximately 140 metres to Grid Reference 44920 43191 (Point D).	0.9m

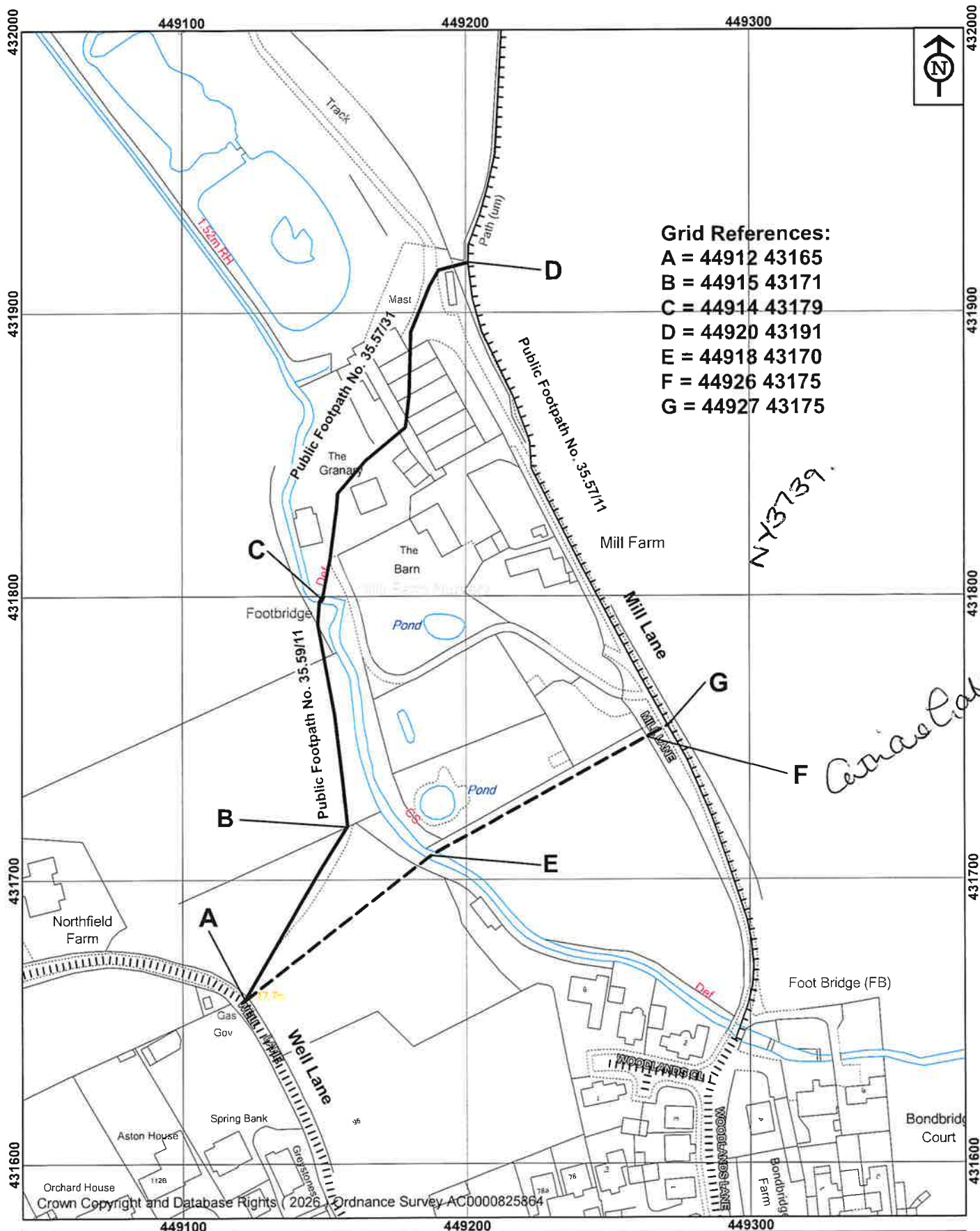
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PUBLIC FOOTPATH

<u>Section of Footpath as shown on the attached map</u>	<u>Position</u>	<u>Width</u>
Public Footpath No. 35.59/11 marked by a bold broken line and shown as A-E-F-G on the attached plan.	Commences at its junction with Well Lane at Grid Reference 44912 43165 (Point A) and runs in a generally east north east direction for approximately 83 metres to a bridge with pedestrian gates at either end at Grid Reference 44918 43170 (Point E) then continues in a generally east north east direction for approximately 87 metres to a pedestrian gate at Grid Reference 44926 43175 (Point F) all on a grass surface. Then continuing in a generally east north east direction for approximately 8 metres to its junction with Mill Lane at Grid Reference 44927 43175 (Point G) on a stone surface. Total length approximately 178 metres.	2m

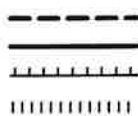
