

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(20 MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) **(VARIOUS ROADS, DISHFORTH)** **ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 31 July 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour and 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 below. The orders specified in column 1 in Schedule 3 below are to be revoked in their entirety: -

SCHEDULE 1

ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF DISHFORTH

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Back Lane (U779/2/70)	From a point 12 metres South West of the centre line of its junction with U777/2/30 Dishforth Village to a point 508 metres away measured along the centre line of Back Lane in a Southerly Direction.
2.	Grange Close (U3191/2/50)	In its entirety
3.	Moor Lane (U778/2/70), Dishforth Village	From its junction with U779/2/70 Back Lane to a point 69 metres away in a South Westerly Direction measured along the centre line of Moor Lane.

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

3.	Moor Lane (U778/2/70), Dishforth Village	From a point 69 metres away from its junction with U779/2/70 Back Lane measured along the centre line of Moor Lane to its end.

4.	Lingham Lane (U782/2/30 & U782/2/70)	In its entirety

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 31 July 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
