NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 **THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**

PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO. 05.13/1, PEAT GHYLL HEAD BARN, CONONLEY, **DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

On 11.08.26, The North Yorkshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the Public Bridleway.

Public Bridleway No. 05.13/1 between SD 9756 4774 and SD 9750 4760 will be diverted onto a new route in a southwest direction between SD 9756 4774 and SD 9750 4760.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at South Craven Community Library, Cross Hills, North Yorkshire, BD20 8TQ until 15.10.26. Copies of the Order and Map may be purchased from Countryside Access Service, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices.

The Order comes into force on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, described in part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 03.09.26, make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the Public Bridleway described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Public Bridleway should be diverted.

Mr David Wilson of Peat Ghyll Head Barn, Cononley has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

Cononley Parish Council and Carleton in Craven Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Peat Ghyll Head Barn and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of way, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be a Public Bridleway over the land situated at Peat Ghyll Head Barn described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The following works shall be carried out by the applicant in relation to the highway described in part 2 of the Schedule: the eastern edge of the Public Bridleway will be 3m away from the southwest corner of the concrete pad at Point C. The southern edge of the Public Bridleway will be at least 1.3m away from the base of the wall that it runs parallel to, between Point E and Point B. At Point B there will be a field gate to BS5709:2018, with a minimum internal width of 8ft, and the southern gate post will be at least 1.3m away from the base of the same wall i.e. where clapping post is currently sited.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

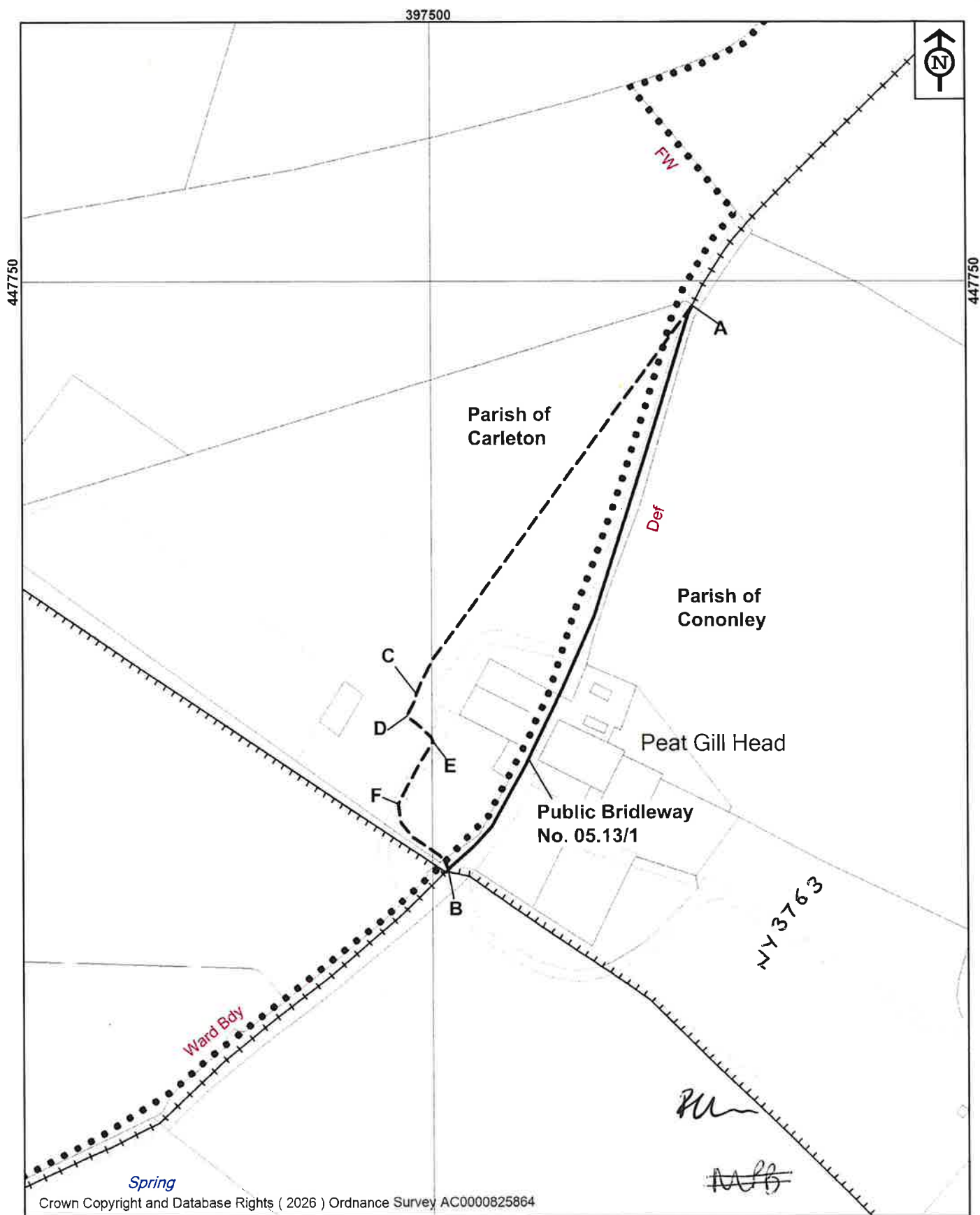

Marked by a bold broken line and shown as A-C-D-E-F-B on the attached plan.	From Grid Reference 39756 44774 (Point A) and runs on a grass surface, in a generally south west direction for approximately 120 metres to Grid Reference 39749 44764 (Point C), then runs on a compacted crushed stone surface, in a generally south west direction for approximately 6 metres to Grid Reference 39749 44764 (Point D), then runs on a compacted crushed stone surface, in a generally south east direction for approximately 9 metres to Grid Reference 39750 44763 (Point E) then runs on a compacted crushed stone surface, in a generally south south west direction for approximately 18 metres to Grid Reference 39749 44761 (Point F) and then continues to run on a compacted crushed stone surface in a generally south east direction for approximately 22 metres to a field gate at Grid Reference 39750 44760 (Point B).	4 metres

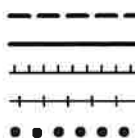
