**NOTICE OF MAKING OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO'S 15.55/58 & 15.55/53, THROSTLE NEST FARM, HARTWITH CUM
WINSLEY, DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

The above Order, made on 28 July 2026, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the Public Footpath described below and modify The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map and Statement accordingly.

Public Footpath No. 15.55/58 between Grid Reference 42083 46035 and 42082 46030 will be diverted onto a new alignment. It will also terminate at its new junction with Public Footpath 15.55/53. Public Footpath No. 15.55/53 between Grid Reference 42065 46027 and 42076 46018 will also be diverted onto a new alignment.

A copy of the Order and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Nidderdale Plus Community Library, Station Square, King Street, Pateley Bridge, North Yorkshire until 8 October 2026. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from the Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2.00, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Paul Dwyer, Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire DL7 8AD or e-mailed to paul.dwyer@northyorks.gov.uk not later than 8 October 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The North Yorkshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

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HARTWITH CUM WINSLEY, DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the Public Footpaths described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.

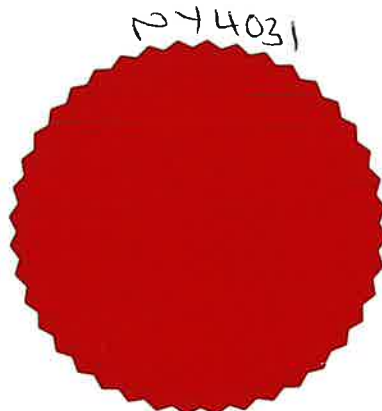
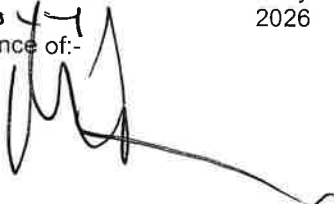
Nicholas Scott, Throstle Nest Farm, Summerbridge, HG3 4JS has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Hartwith cum Winsley Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Throstle Nest Farm, Hartwith cum Winsley described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order shall be stopped up from the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed, and thereupon The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be a Public Footpath over the land situated at Throstle Nest Farm, Hartwith cum Winsley described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
3. The following works shall be carried out by the applicant in relation to the highway described in part 2 of the Schedule: install pedestrian gates at Points E, J and F and create a gap at Point I.
4. The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

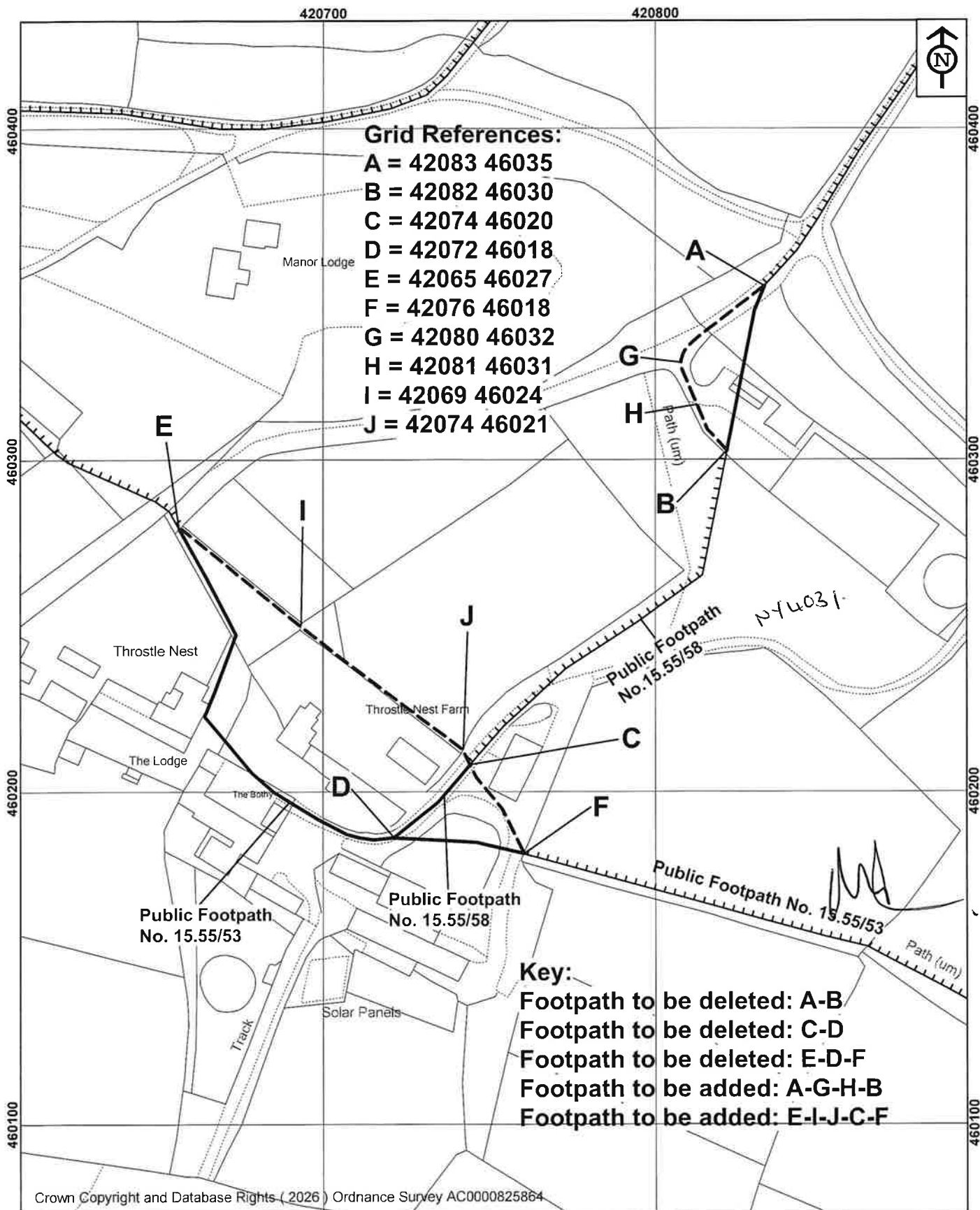

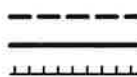
