(HANKS MEADOW, SCARBOROUGH) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2011
(AMENDMENT NO 119) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 18 September 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) and 45 to 49 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "The Borough of Scarborough (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Consolidation Order 2011" by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

Location	Road	Side	From	To	Restriction
Scarborough	Hanks Meadow	West-North-East	A point at the junction markings on Overdale	Proceeding for a distance of 242m along Hanks Meadow to a point level with the junction markings on Overdale	No waiting at any time
Scarborough	Hanks Meadow	North-East-South-West	Turning island	Around for 55m	No waiting at any time

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 18 September 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
