(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) **(RICCALL LANE, KELFIELD)** **ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 04 September 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

SCHEDULE **40 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

1.	Riccall Lane, Kelfield	The 40mph speed limit will be introduced from the existing 30mph signs in an easterly direction for 356m.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 18 September 2026, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Barlby Library and Community Hub, Howden Road, Barlby, Selby YO8 5JE during normal office hours from 17 September 2026 until 16 October 2026 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 04 September 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
