

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL
(SCHOOL STREETS, GLADSTONE ROAD PRIMARY SCHOOL, SCARBOROUGH) (PROHIBITION
OF DRIVING)
EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on Friday, 11 September 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles as set out in Schedule 1 below, for an experimental period of eighteen months.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on Monday, 05 October 2026, together with a map showing the road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at County Hall, Northallerton and at Scarborough Library & Information Centre, Vernon Road, Scarborough YO11 2NN during normal office hours from Thursday, 24 September 2026 until 23 March 2028 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

The Council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified, from the coming into force of that variation or modification (whichever is the later), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.

Any person wishing to object to the indefinite continuation of the Order must state the grounds for their objection, in writing, addressed to **Area 3 Highways Depot, Discovery Way, Whitby, North Yorkshire YO22 4PZ** or by email to **Area3.Whitby@northyorks.gov.uk** or via the website link **above**. by Sunday, 04 April 2027.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the above Experimental Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, they may, within six weeks of Friday, 11 September 2026 make application to the High Court for that purpose.
