(CROSBY ROAD, NORTHALLERTON) (AMENDMENT NO TBC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Hambleton) (Amendment No 1) Order 2020" by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedules below:-

Northallerton	Crosby Road	West	From its junction with the centre line of Colstan Road, northwards for a distance of 30.1 metres
Northallerton	Crosby Road	West	From its junction with the centre line of Colstan Road southwards for a distance of 40.4 metres
Northallerton	Crosby Road	East	From its kerb line intercept with Greenhowsyke Lane, southwards for a distance of 20.4 metres
