(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(MAIN STREET, INGLETON) (AMENDMENT NO TBC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Craven) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedule 1 and 2 below:-

WAITING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES WITH EXEMPTIONS

2	Main Street (C385), Ingleton	Southeast	From its intersection point with the projected southwestern boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café to a point 2 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected southwestern boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café.
3	Main Street (C385), Ingleton	Southeast	From a point 7 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected southwestern boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café to a point 9.8 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected southwestern boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café.
4	Main Street (C385), Ingleton	Southeast	From a point 18.5 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected southwestern boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café to a point 22.2 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected south western boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café.
5	Main Street (C385), Ingleton	Southeast	From a point 22.2 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected southwestern boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café to a point 76 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected south western boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café.

3	Main Street (C385), Ingleton	Southeast	From a point 9.8 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected southwestern boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café to a point 18.5 metres northeast of its intersection point with the projected south western boundary line of Curlew Cottage/ Gem Café.
