(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(THE SQUARE, INGLETON) (AMENDMENT NO TBC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Craven) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedule below:-

1	The Square (U715), Ingleton	Northeast/ East	From its intersection point with the northwestern kerb line of High Street (U673) for a distance of 30 metres in a north/ north westerly direction, measured along the eastern channel line of The Square.
2	The Square (U715), Ingleton	West/ Southwest	From its intersection point with the northwestern kerb line of Main Street (U673) for a distance of 37.8 metres in a north/ north westerly direction, measured along the western channel line of The Square.
3	The Square (U715), Ingleton	North	From its intersection point with the northwestern kerb line of Thacking Lane (at the projected eastern building line of Ingleton Chippy) for a distance of 13 metres in a westerly direction.
4	Thacking Lane (U715), Ingleton	Northwest	From its intersection point with the northern channel line of The Square (at the projected eastern building line of Ingleton Chippy) for a distance of 4.1 metres in a north easterly direction.
