	It tells you about what we want do to help young people with special educational needs and disabilities. This is called SEND.

The money is to make more education places or to make school buildings better for young people with SEND with an Education Health and Care Plan.

This is called an EHCP.



Why do we need more education places?

We need more places because there are more young people with SEND than there used to be.



What are we doing now?

We are asking you to tell us what you think about two ideas for how to spend the money from the government – we will listen to your views.





Then we will write a report that says how the money could be spent.



We will also look at our long term plan to help decide where to spend the money.

This is called our strategic plan.

The report will say what we think the most important things to spend the money on are.

It will be ready in March 2019.





What are the ideas?

The ideas are to do some work at Brooklands Community Special School in Skipton.

And to do some work at the proposed satellite provision for Mowbray School in Ripon.

'Satellite provision' means that there will be an extra part of Mowbray School in Ripon.



Brooklands Community Special School - Skipton

We need more places for young people with SEND to go to school in the Craven area.



We want to do some work to the building so that up to 8 more students can go to this school.





We also want to build a changing area and a place to have a shower.



We would spend £79,600 of the capital fund.



Mowbray Satellite in Ripon

We need more places for young people with SEND to go to school in the Ripon area.



We would spend the rest of the money from the government to set up an extra part of Mowbray School in Ripon.





We want 30 students to go there at first, then 60 in the future.
