	<p>How did we write the plan?</p>
	<p>We asked people to tell us what they thought was important, and what should be in the plan.</p>



We held events for children and young people with SEND; parents and carers; and people who work with them



Then, when the plan was written, we asked people to tell us if they agreed or disagreed with it.



People told us that overall they liked what is in the plan. They thought some things should be changed.



We listened and made some changes to the plan.



What does our plan say?






The plan says we have to make sure that all children and young people with SEND can learn.

This could be in school or college.

Or it could be somewhere else if that is better for them.



The plan says we want children and young people with SEND to be with their friends.

	<p>And we want them to go to school as close to their home as possible.</p>
	<p>The plan says we want children and young people with SEND to do well with their learning and be ready for adult life.</p>
	<p>The plan says we have to make sure there is enough education support for children and young people with SEND.</p> <p>It says we will need to have more education places.</p> <p>This means we can support more young people.</p>



But we must do this with the money we have – this is called our ‘high needs budget’.



It will take us several years to do all the things in the plan.



We will check regularly to make sure we are keeping on track with the plan and things are getting better.







We will ask children and young people and parents or carers whether they think the plan is working.



We will look at how well children and young people with SEND are doing at school and in other parts of their life.



There is a second part to the plan (called 'phase 2'), which is about some more work that we need to do to make sure there are enough places for children and young people with SEND.
