Who are we?

North Yorkshire County Council is a 'Data Controller' as defined by Article 4(7) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The Building Bridges team will work with children who show high levels of disengagement and challenging behaviour and are often prone to absenteeism from school. The team will provide intensive support to those children and families who need it most and looks to develop a relationship-based model across the school, home and community.

What personal information do we collect?

The information we collect may include

- Name
- Address
- School Attended and educational information.
- Identifiers including NHS number.
- Contact details such as telephone numbers or email addresses.

Special category data may include

- Religion
- Health data
- Ethnicity
- Sexual orientation
- Criminal History

If your personal details change, it is your responsibility to inform the project team.

Why do we collect your personal information?

In order to work with you and deliver the short-term intervention, we will need to collect your personal information.

Who do we share this information with?

This information will be shared between the project team and the school attended.

How long do we keep your information for?

What is our lawful basis for processing your information?
