This Privacy Notice is designed to help you understand how and why your personal data is processed in relation to the Go Local volunteer campaign. This notice should be read in conjunction with the Council's [Corporate Privacy Notice](#).

Who are we?

North Yorkshire County Council is a 'Data Controller' as defined by Article 4(7) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The Council is collecting your data through a 'Registration of Interest' form as part of our work with community transport providers to recruit volunteers.

What personal information do we collect?

For the Go Local volunteer recruitment campaign we will collect your name, address, telephone number and email address through our 'Registration of Interest' form.

Why do we collect your personal information?

We are collecting this information to connect you with your nearest community transport provider so they can review your application to be a Go Local volunteer and to contact you in regards to the application

Who do we share this information with?

Your personal information will only be shared with the relevant community transport provider who is involved in the Go Local service.

How long do we keep your information for?

We will retain the information you provided at the point you registered your interest in volunteering for this service until a Go Local community transport provider has been allocated, it will then be deleted by NYCC after two years.

What is our lawful basis for processing your information?

Your information will only be processed with your Consent. By completing the 'Registration of Interest' form and ticking the 'consent box' you are giving consent for us to process your information for the above purposes.
