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## North Yorkshire County Council Approved Provider List for Non- Regulated Services

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The Council's Approved Provider List for Non-Regulated Services has now been published on YORtender. For the purposes of this Approved Provider List, the term 'Non-Regulated Services' refers to a range of support services that are not regulated by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) but may be accessed by children, young adults, adults and older people who are ordinarily resident in North Yorkshire and may wish to receive community based support, which may include support in their own home but not personal care.

Examples of Non-Regulated Services include (but are not limited to):

- Collective Care Settings i.e. day time activities for groups in one venue, purchased on an individual basis;
- Collective Care Settings for employment training i.e. Sheltered workshops;
- Non Collective Care Settings i.e. day time activities for individual people;
- Non Collective Care Home Based Settings i.e. sitting services ; and
- Practical Support Services i.e. home improvements, telecare, shopping, cleaning and pet services.

The current Approved Provider List for Non-Regulated Services commenced on 1 March 2017 and the Council requested that applications for inclusion onto this Approved Provider List were received no later than 30<sup>th</sup> April 2017.

This allowed a period of four weeks for Providers to submit their application and the Council confirmed that during this period new placements would continue to be made.

It has become apparent that we still have a number of Providers within North Yorkshire who have not applied to the Approved Provider List for Non-Regulated Services. To ensure that Providers can continue to receive placements from the Council whilst they submit their applications the deadline has been extended until Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

If your organisation has not submitted an application by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2017, the Council shall not be in a position to continue making new placements with your organisation until the application process has been completed. However, existing ISC's will continue.

Please note that the Council will not be in a position to provide any further extensions to deadlines and Providers are urged to submit their applications by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

New and existing providers of Non-Regulated Services who wish to apply to join the Approved Provider List but have not previously registered an interest on YORtender can access the application documents by doing so now (please see attached guidance). Providers who have previously registered an interest in the opportunity should be able to access the application documents by logging into YORtender, clicking on "My Activities", selecting "North Yorkshire County Council" pressing the green "Update" button and selecting "Non-Regulated Services Approved Provider List".

Applications from potential providers who have not previously been on the Council's Approved Provider List for Non-Regulated Services will be processed as they are received and new packages of support may be sourced once these applications have been approved by the Council.
