Building Blocks for Language & Small Talk	<p>Are you worried about your child's speech and language development? We offer two play based programmes which give information and practical activities to support your child's speech and language. They are both aimed at parents and children together. For you to take part in one of these programmes, a referral is required from either a Speech and Language Therapist, your Early Years setting or the Health Visiting Team. Please ring the Children's Centre for information about the next Speech and Language Drop-in dates.</p> <p>Small Talk is for 1 - 2 year olds and is 6 weeks long Building Blocks for Language is for 2 - 3 year olds and is 7 weeks long</p>
Healthy Start Vitamins 	<p>Healthy Start Vitamins can be purchased from the Children's Centres. They cost just £1.40 for the Children's vitamin drops and 75p for the Women's vitamin tablets. We also accept the Healthy Start vouchers. Healthy Start vitamins are suitable for vegetarians and halal diets, and free from milk, egg, gluten, soya and peanut residues.</p> <p>Please enquire at Children's Centre receptions.</p>
Breastfeeding Support	<p>The Health Visiting Service from Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust and the Early Help Service from North Yorkshire County Council are currently working towards UNICEF Baby Friendly Accreditation. The Baby Friendly Initiative works with public services to protect, promote and support breastfeeding and to strengthen mother-baby and family relationships irrespective of the feeding method chosen. 2 Year Old Funding	<p>If you have a 2 year old child and you are in receipt of one of several benefits, you may be eligible for up to 15 hours of funded childcare. 3 & 4 Year Old Funding	<p>Every 3 and 4 year old is entitled to 15 hours of funded childcare per week, but for working parents who meet the national eligibility criteria below, they may be entitled to an extra 15 hours per week, a total of 1140 hours per year.</p> <p>To receive the extended 30 hours entitlement, both parents must be working (or sole parent if in a lone parent family), each having a minimum income of 16 hours at national minimum wage per week, but an income each of less than £100,000 per year.</p> <p>For more information and how to apply visit: https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/early-education-places-and-funding</p>
