

NORTH YORKSHIRE COVID-19 OUTBREAK MANAGEMENT: HIGH RISK SETTINGS (THEME 2)

SUMMARY

Scope

Theme 2: High risk settings, has three sub-themes including:

- 2a – workplace settings
- 2b – accommodation settings – such as homeless provision; hostels; refuges
- 2c – hospitality, leisure and tourism settings/locations – such as hotels, B&Bs, holiday villages, camping and caravanning; pubs and restaurants; leisure facilities; tourism hot spots

This list of settings is not exhaustive and will be reviewed regularly.

Outbreak management approach

The outbreak management approach includes prevention and response, of which Test and Trace forms part of.

There are three levels included in the approach:

- Level 1 – universal prevention – evidence based information, advice, guidance
- Level 2 – targeted prevention – above and bespoke offer where deemed applicable
- Level 3 – outbreak management

Plans will be reviewed and amended to adapt to the situation.

Public Health leads

Consultant in Public Health (High Risk Settings – Workplaces/Housing/Leisure/Tourism) – supported by Health Improvement Managers and Health Improvement Officers

Partnerships/collaboration

The scoping and the outbreak management approaches will be developed and implemented in collaboration with a number of partners, including but not exclusive to:

- North Yorkshire County Council teams – Public Health, Trading Standards, Technology and Change, Marketing and Communications; Resilience and Emergencies
- District and Borough Council teams – including housing; environmental health; communities, leisure and tourism; economic development; community safety partnerships.
- Local Enterprise Partnership
- Local Business Improvement District
- Federation of Small Businesses
- Other multiagency partnership groups as needed
