May I try to summarise my previous thoughts please.

Quarries.

Must be economically accessible to the market bearing in mind vehicle pollution & congestion.

Quality of stone, etc. Must be of the correct quality for industry. There is some rubbish around at moment.

Extraction pollution must be kept to a minimum e.g. Hanson Quarry at Pateley Bridge – going round & round & round!

Sufficient years of life for a long time ahead

Need for correct siting for a 'batching' plant – now every load used around York costs 40 miles pollution before spreading. This does not include the 'pollution' miles bringing the ingredients into the site.

Waste repositories. No matter how much recycling, repackaging, incineration we do there will always be residual waste to dispose of. Make sure there are plenty of places to do this properly.
