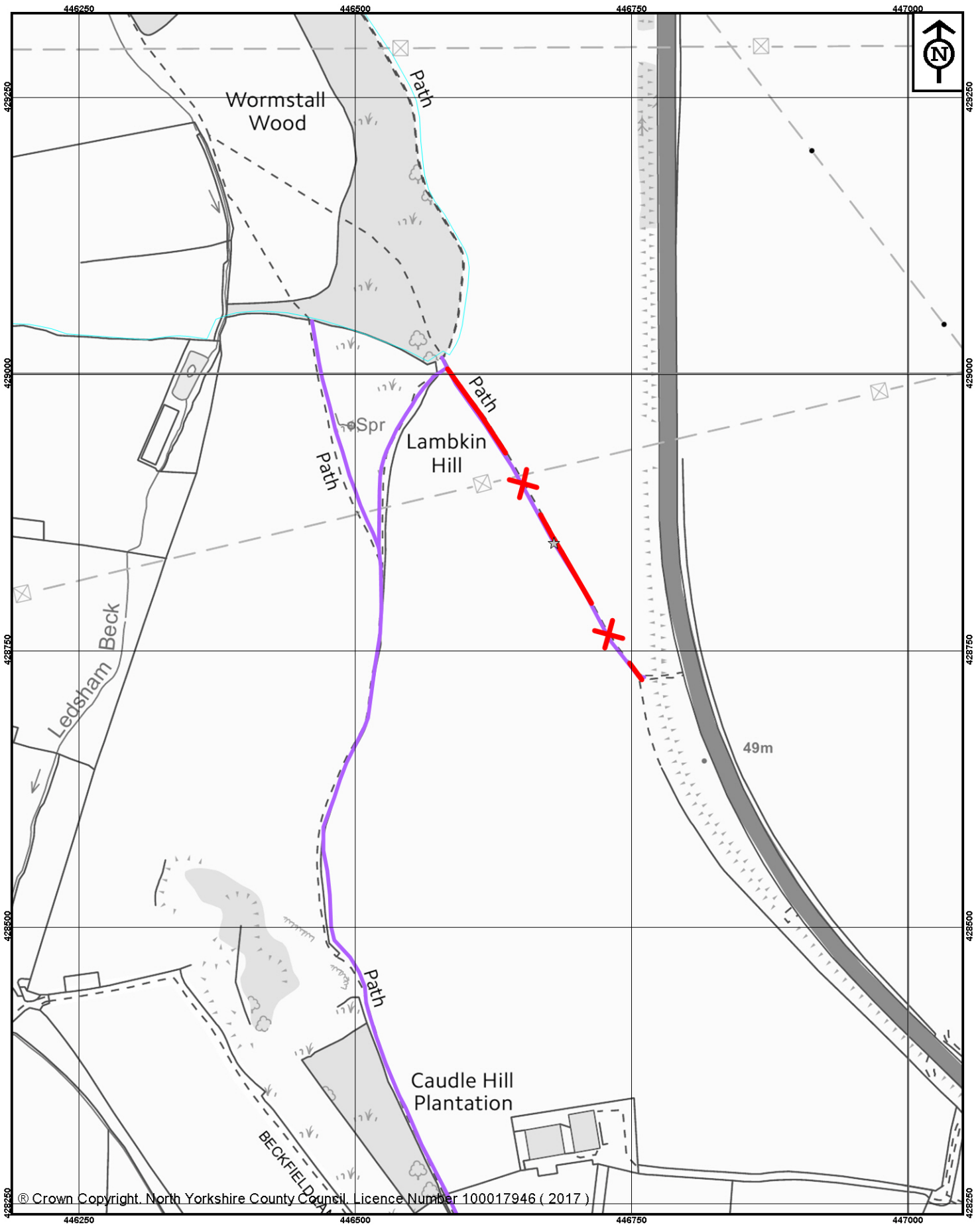
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 35.29/1/2, Fairburn in the District of Selby (between grid references SE46762872 and SE46592899) for a temporary period of six months (subject to access to premises) between 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017 and 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2017, due to Regional National Grid overhead line refurbishment and replacement of electrical apparatus on the 4ZZ OHL. The closure period will only apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and there is no alternative route available.
