#### PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY 05.5/13 BENTHAM DIVERSION ORDER 2022

This Order is made by North Yorkshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner(s) of the land crossed by the Bridleway described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Path(s) should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that The District Of Craven (outside The Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Wenningdale Escapes, Bentham Golf Course, High Bentham LA2 7AG has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the Path(s) into a fit condition for use by the public.

Craven District Council and Bentham Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

#### BY THIS ORDER:

- 1.t The public right of way over the land situated at Bentham Golf Course, Robin Lane, Bentham andt shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of thet Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, int accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, ast described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of thet Authority and thereupon the District Of Craven (outside The Yorkshire Dales National Park)t Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way. Under no circumstancest shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.t
- 2.t There shall from the date of the above-mentioned certification be a public Bridleway over the landt situated at Bentham Golf Course, Robin Lane, Bentham described in Part 2 of the Schedule to thist Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and thereupon thet District Of Craven (outside The Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified byt adding that public bridleway to it.t
- 2A. The District Of Craven (outside The Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

3.t The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditionst set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.t







### PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY 05.5/13 BENTHAM DIVERSION ORDER 2022

The above Order, made on Tuesday 22 November 2022, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the Bridleway described below.

Public Bridleway Bentham 05.5/13 proceeding between SD 6697 6996 and SD 6737 7005 (Points A to E on the Plan) along a track, will be diverted onto a parallel grass surface from SD 6697 6996 to SD 6709 6999 (Point C) where it crosses Footpath 05.5/104, continuing to SD 6737 7005 to re-join the current route.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Ingleton Community Library, Main Street, Ingleton LA6 3HG (TEL: 01609 534504), North Yorkshire until Saturday 7th January 2023. Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Yorkshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
