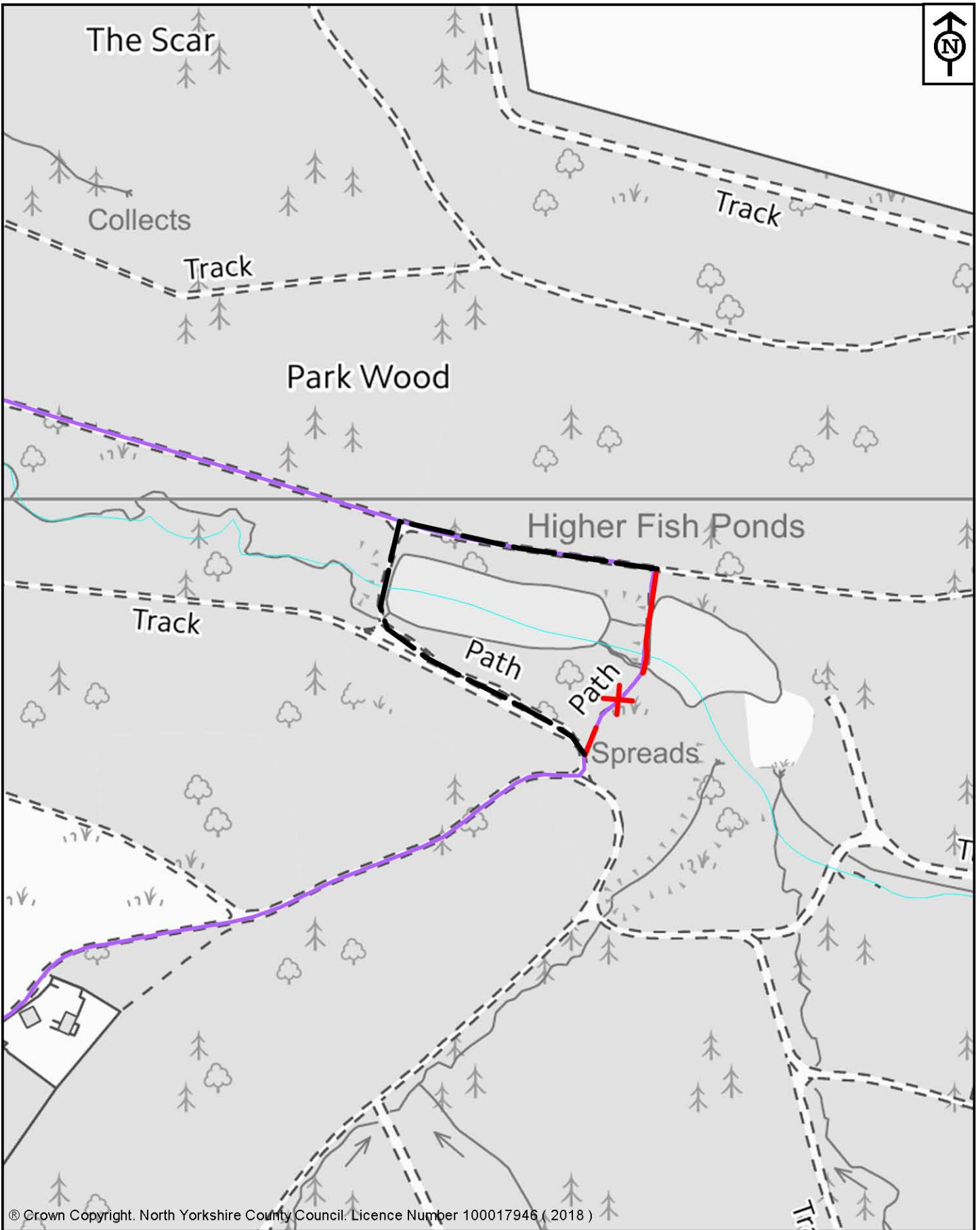
North Yorkshire County Council hereby gives notice that from 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018 until 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018 inclusive, no pedestrian shall proceed along Public Footpaths 10.175/10/1 Yearsley, Hambleton and 25.40/5/3, Gilling East, Ryedale, between grid reference SE59577595 and SE59537585 (subject to access to premises) due to a flood damaged culvert crossing requiring replacement. This Emergency Closure will be followed by a six month closure until 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
