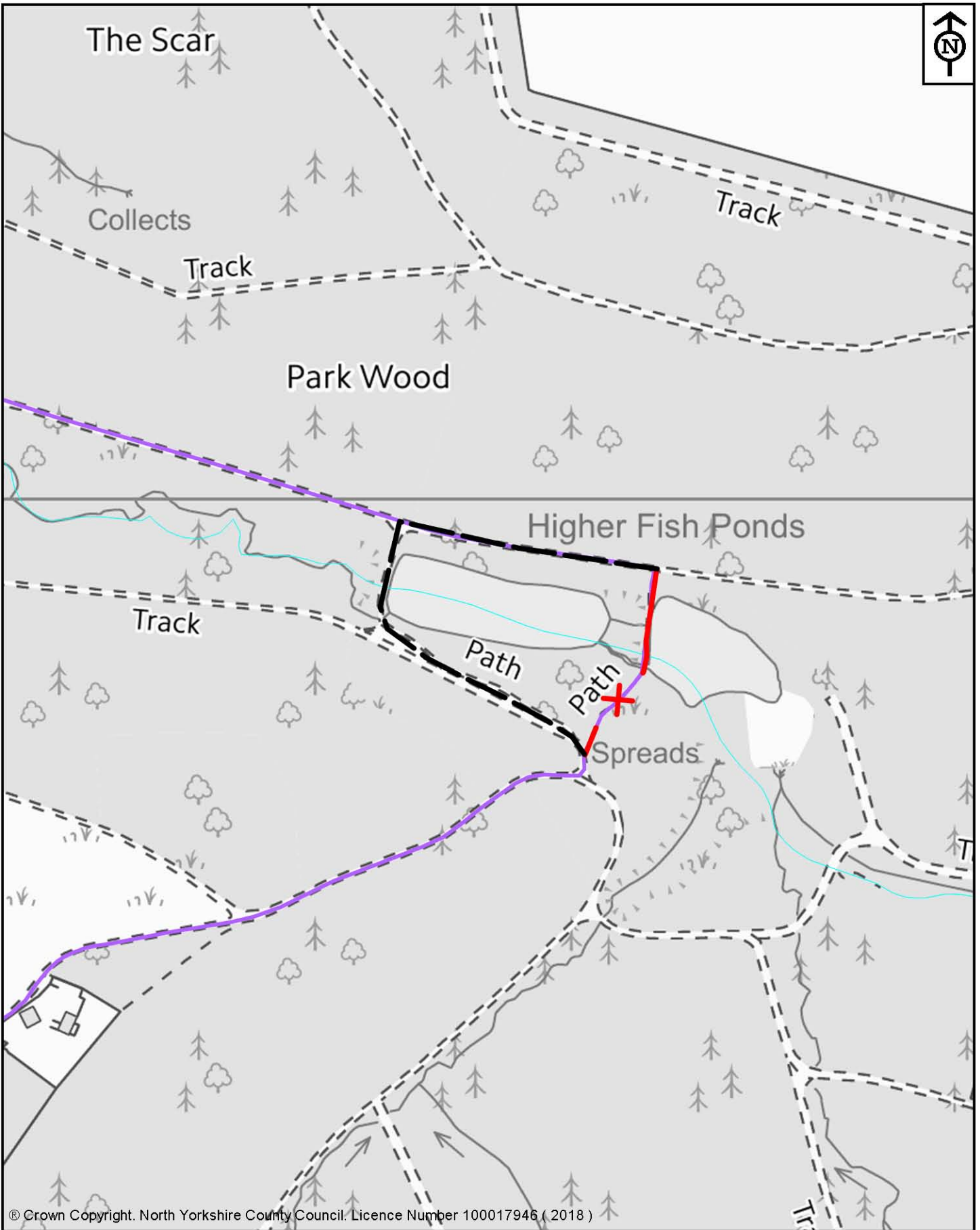

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any public access along public footpaths 10.175/10/1 Yearsley in Hambleton and 25.40/5/3 Gilling East in Ryedale between grid reference SE59577595 and SE59537585 for a temporary period of six months commencing 2 February 2018 due to a flood damaged culvert crossing requiring replacement. This Order follows Emergency Notice 005 dated 11.01.2018.

The closure period will only apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.
