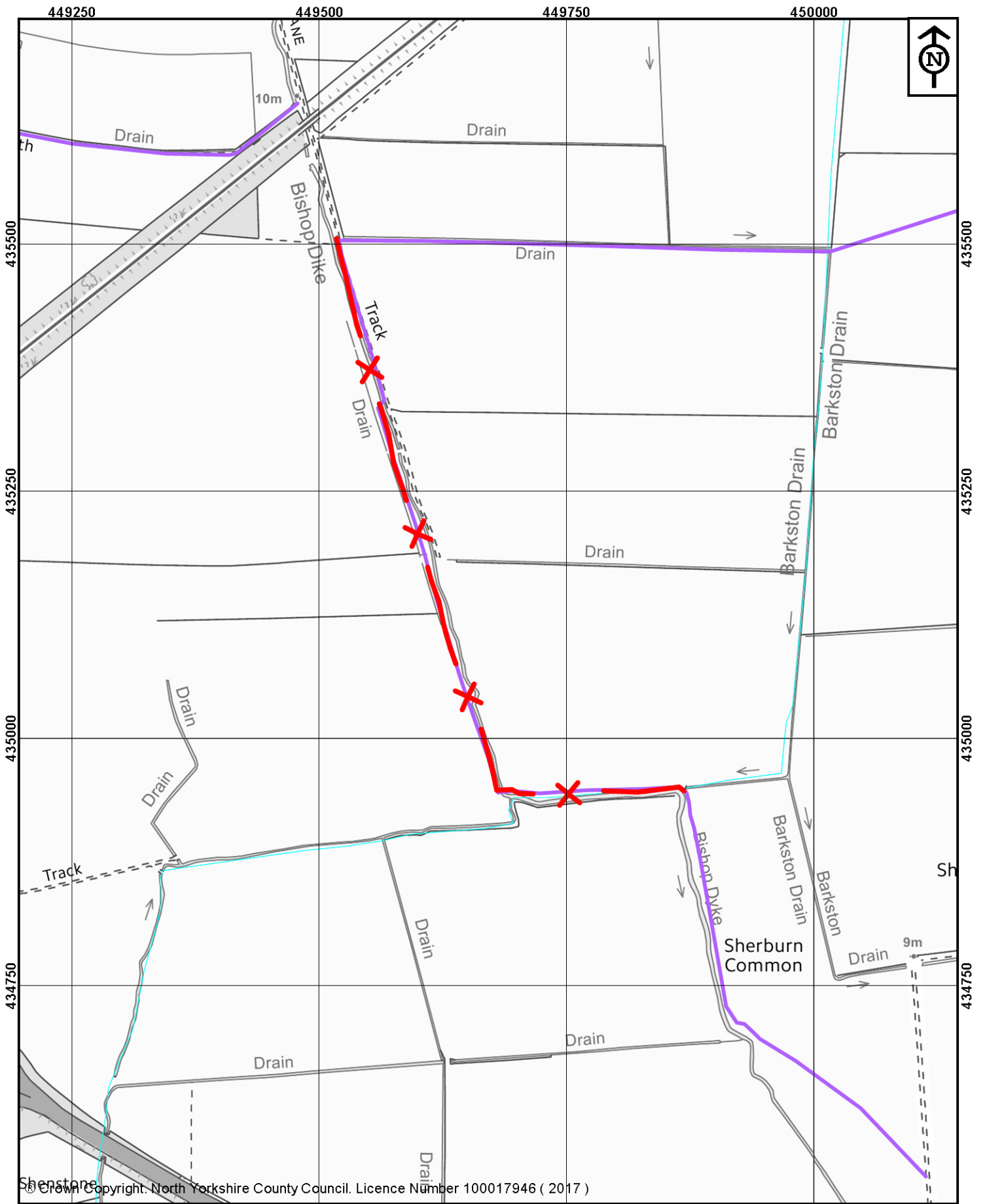
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath No 35.4/8/1 Barkston Ash (between Grid Ref SE49853491 and SE49503549), in the District of Selby for a further temporary period following an emergency closure, from 20/09/2017 and 02/03/2018 due to potential danger to the public because of a dangerous bridge – the closure period will only apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs. No local alternative route is available.
