Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

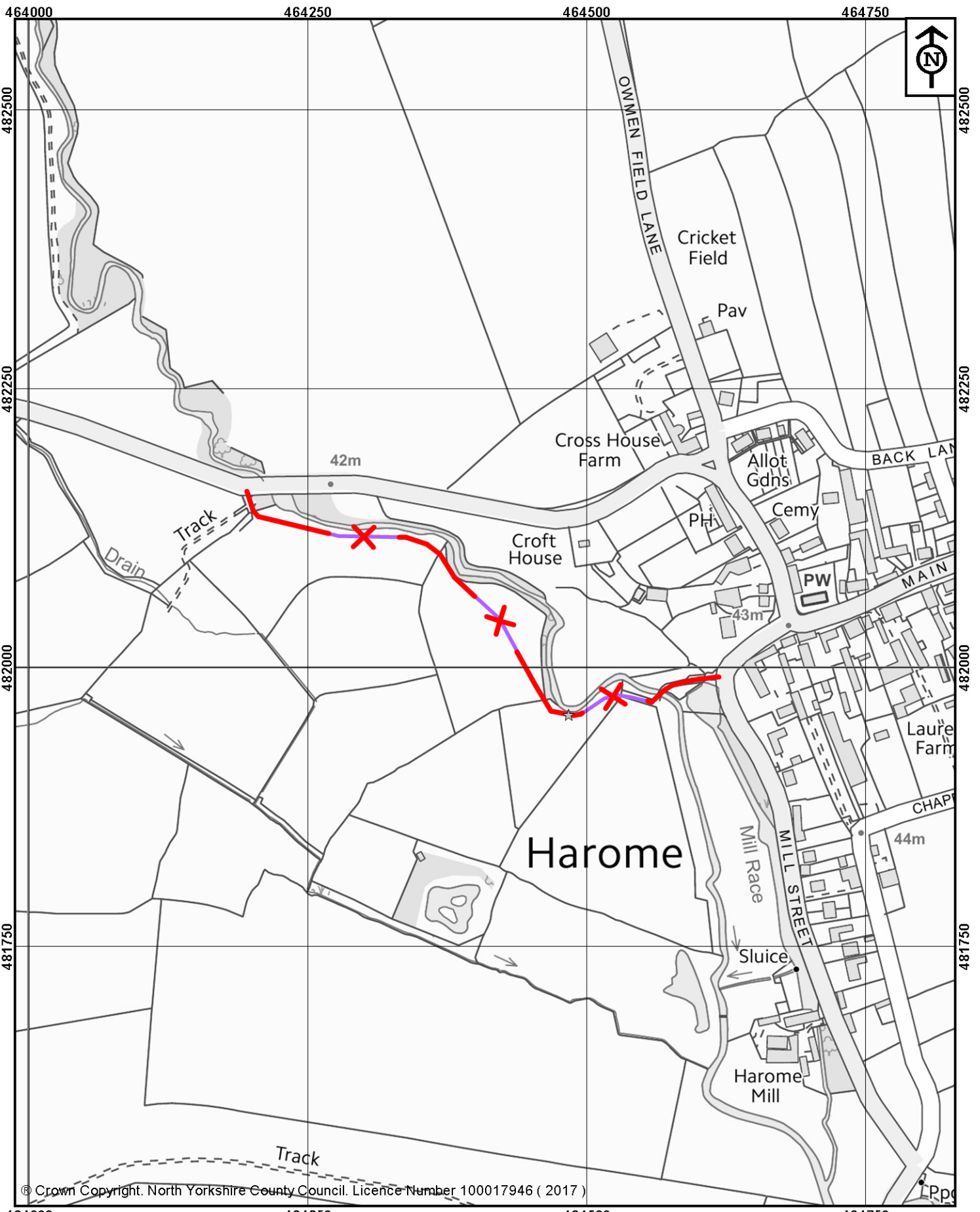
North Yorkshire County Council has made an Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 25.43/1/1, Harome, Ryedale between grid reference SE64198215 and SE64618199 in the District of Ryedale for a temporary period of 6 months (subject to access to premises) between 6th September 2017 and 16th February 2018, **due to a dangerous bridge** – the closure period will only apply as indicated by the placing of traffic. This closure follows an emergency closure which commenced on 16th August 2017.

There is no alternative route available.
