Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

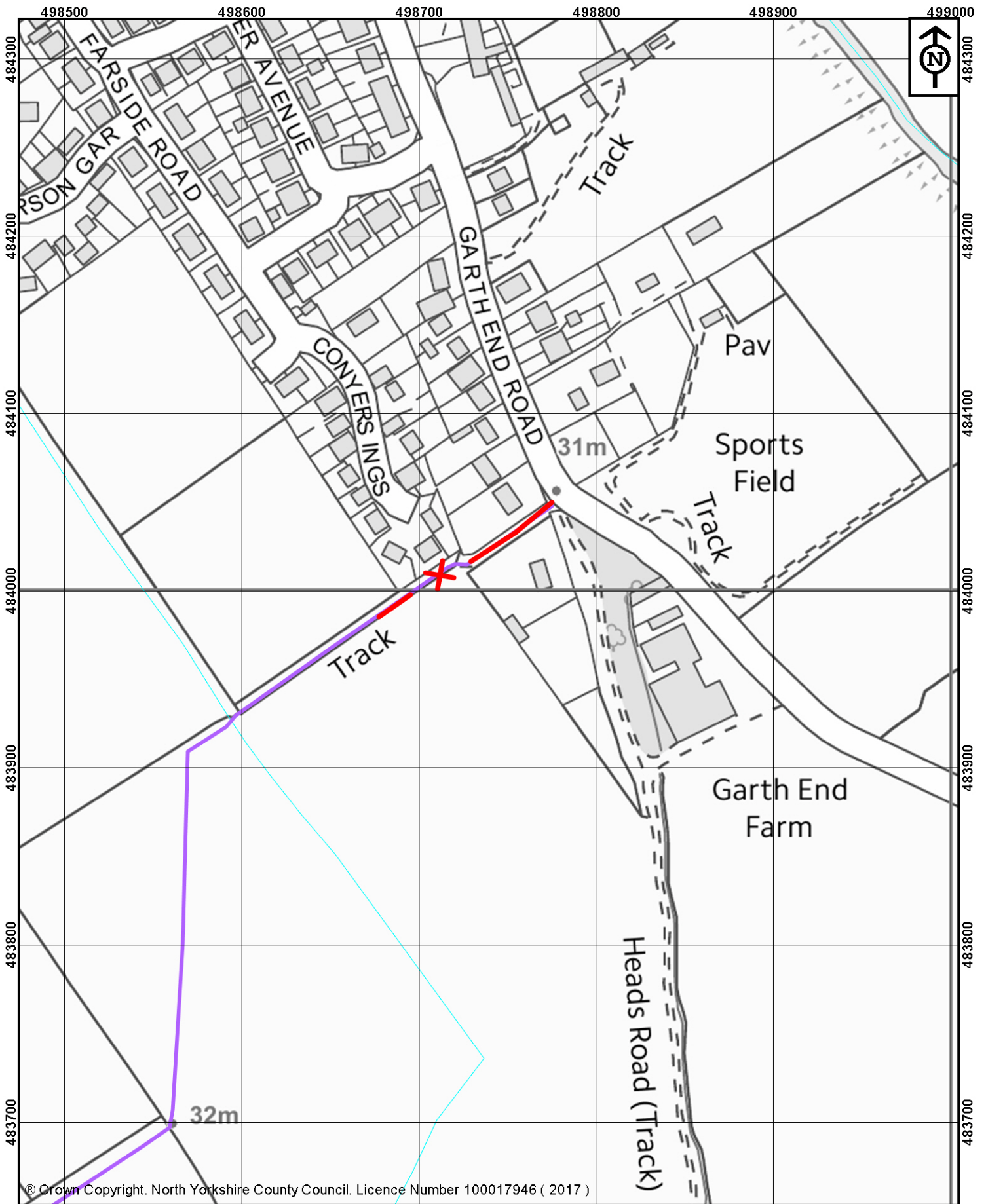
North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 30.22/2/1, West Ayton, Scarborough between grid reference SE98778404 and SE98678398, in the Borough of Scarborough, for a temporary period of 6 months (subject to access to premises) between 2nd October 2017 and 2nd April 2018 due to **installation of a foul water rising main from the development to the public sewer in Garth End Road** – the closure period will only apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.

There is no suitable alternative route available.
