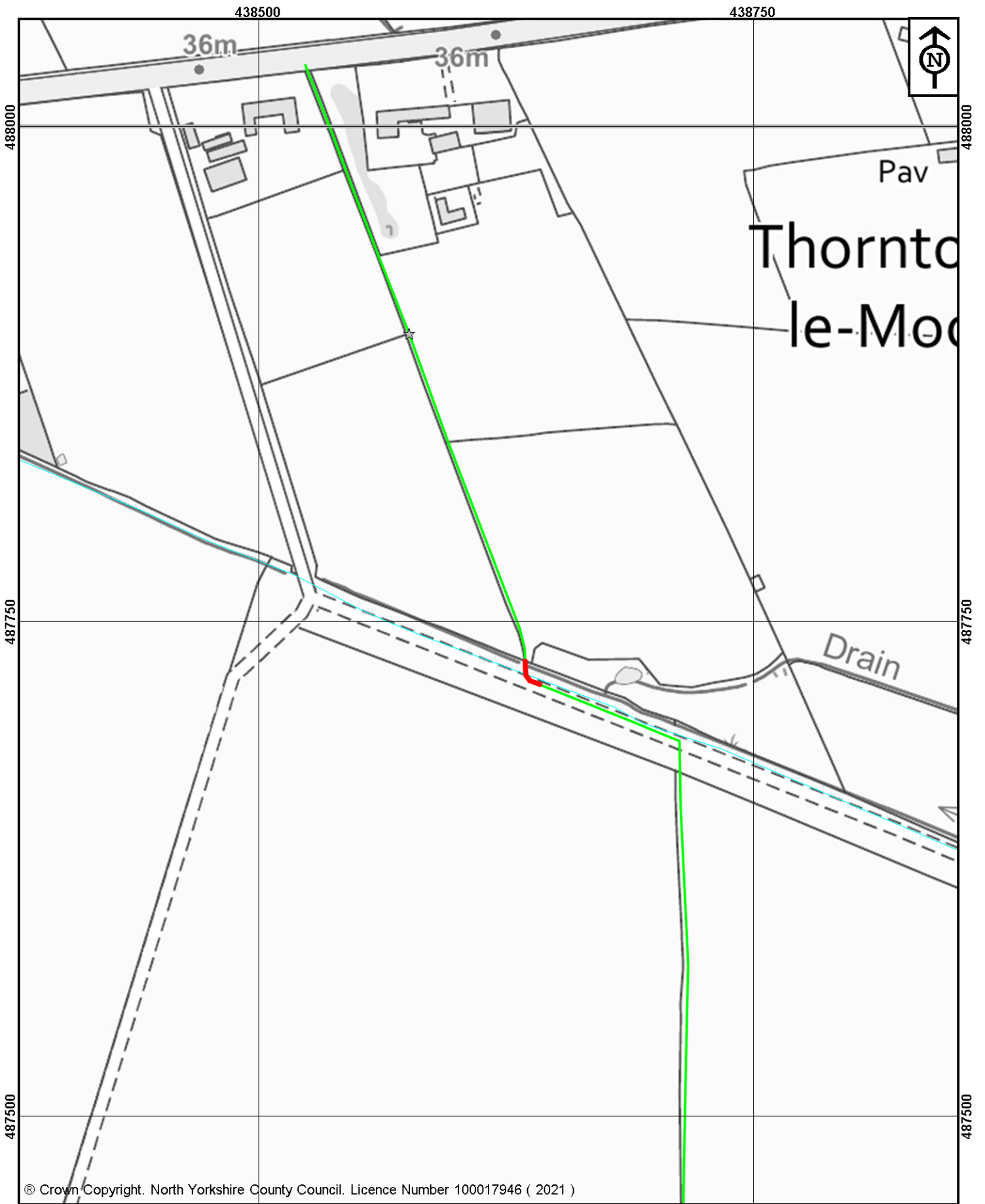
North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using the Public Bridleway 10.155/13/1 Thornton le Moor, Hambleton between grid reference SE38638773 and SE38648771 for a temporary period of six months (subject to access to premises) between 9<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and 17<sup>th</sup> October 2022 due to a rotten bridge in need of replacement. This Order follows a closure under Emergency Notice No 127 which commenced on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2022.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
