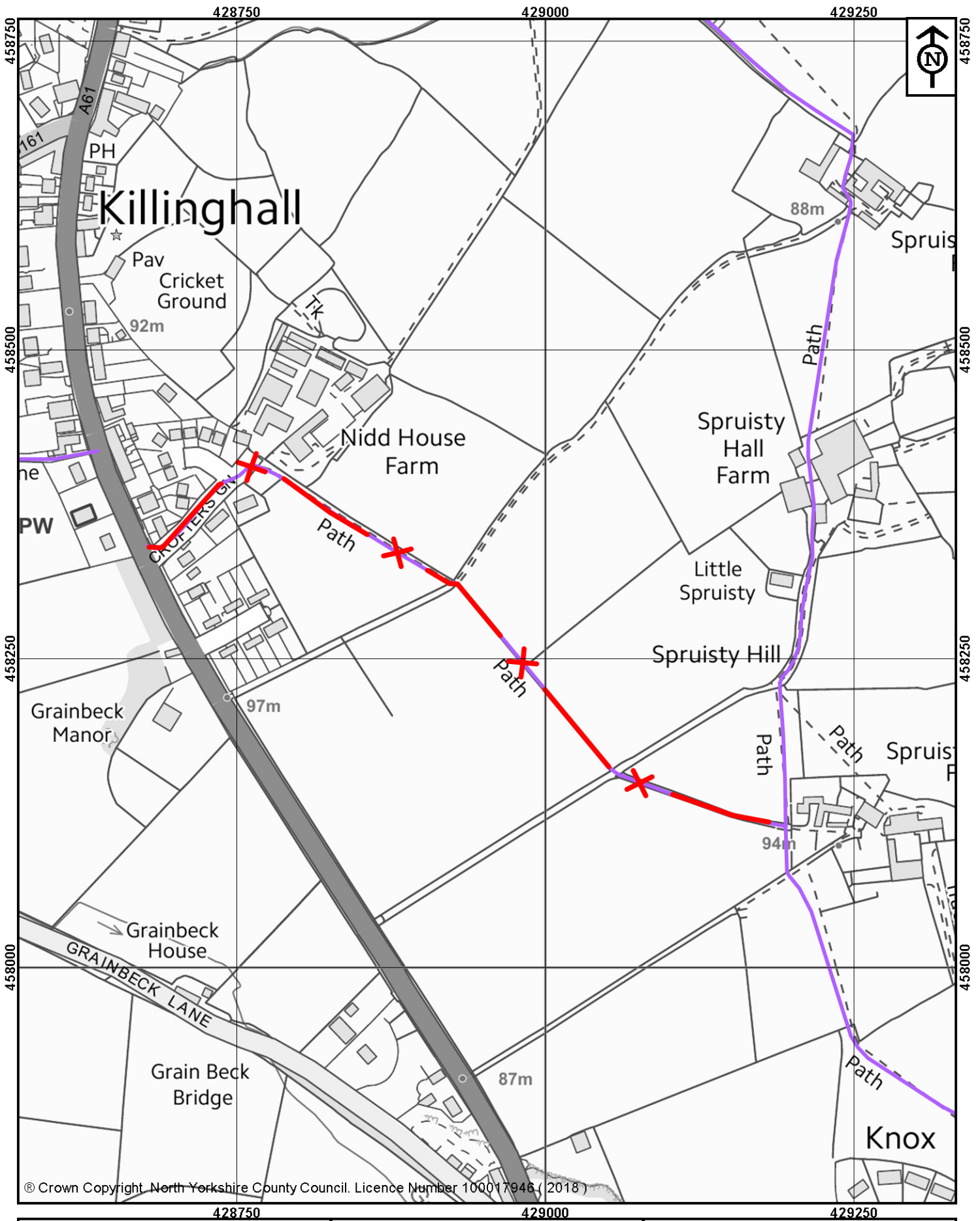
NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpath 15.65/6/1, Killinghall, in the Borough of Harrogate, between grid reference SE28675834 and SE29195811 to ensure public safety during housing development works has been continued in force until 30 September 2020 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
