Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

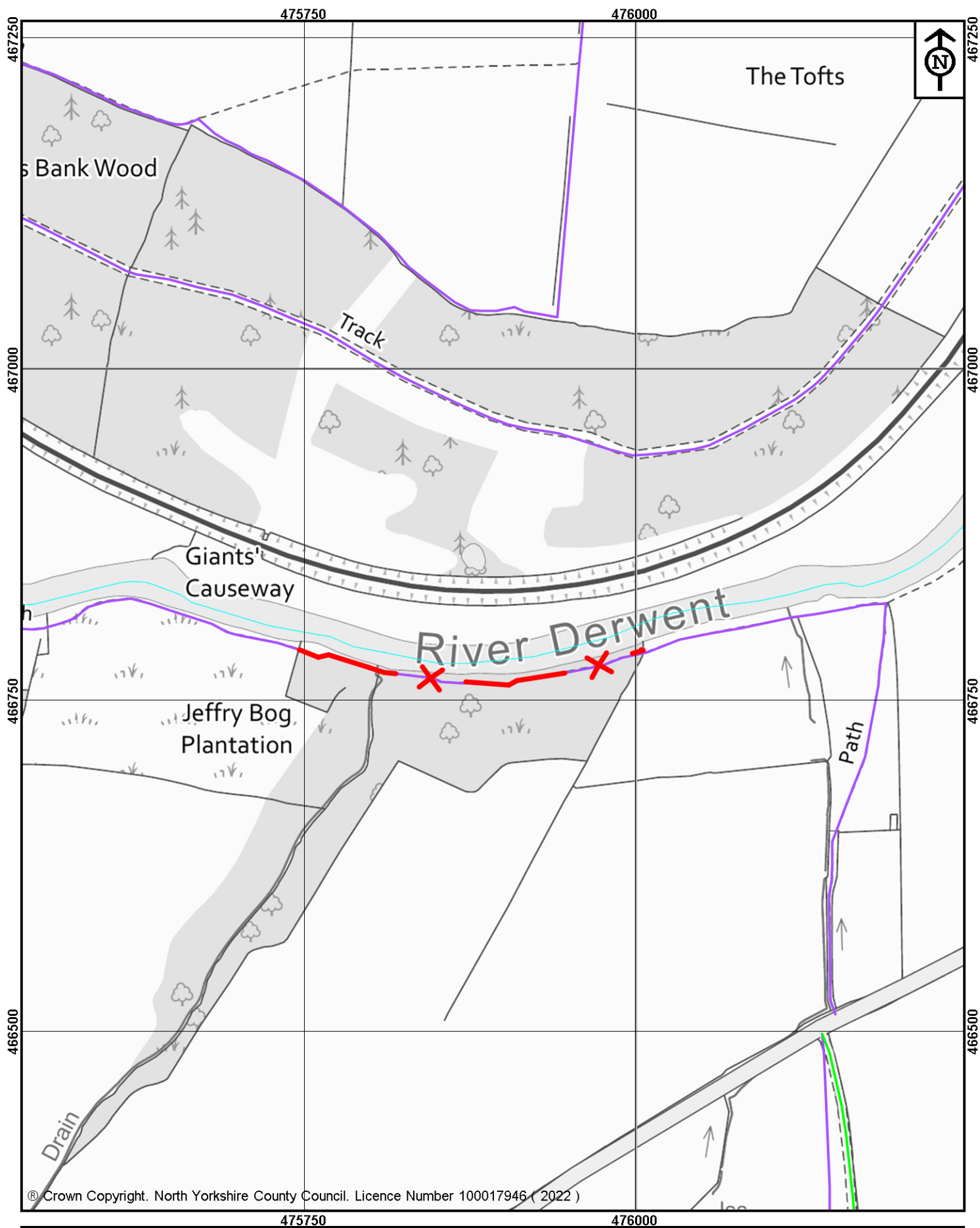
North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath No 25.107/7/1, Westow, Ryedale, between grid reference SE75746678 and SE75996677 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 1st July 2022 and 9th December 2022 due to fallen trees and damaged sections of boardwalk. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 175.

The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.

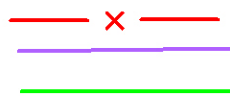
