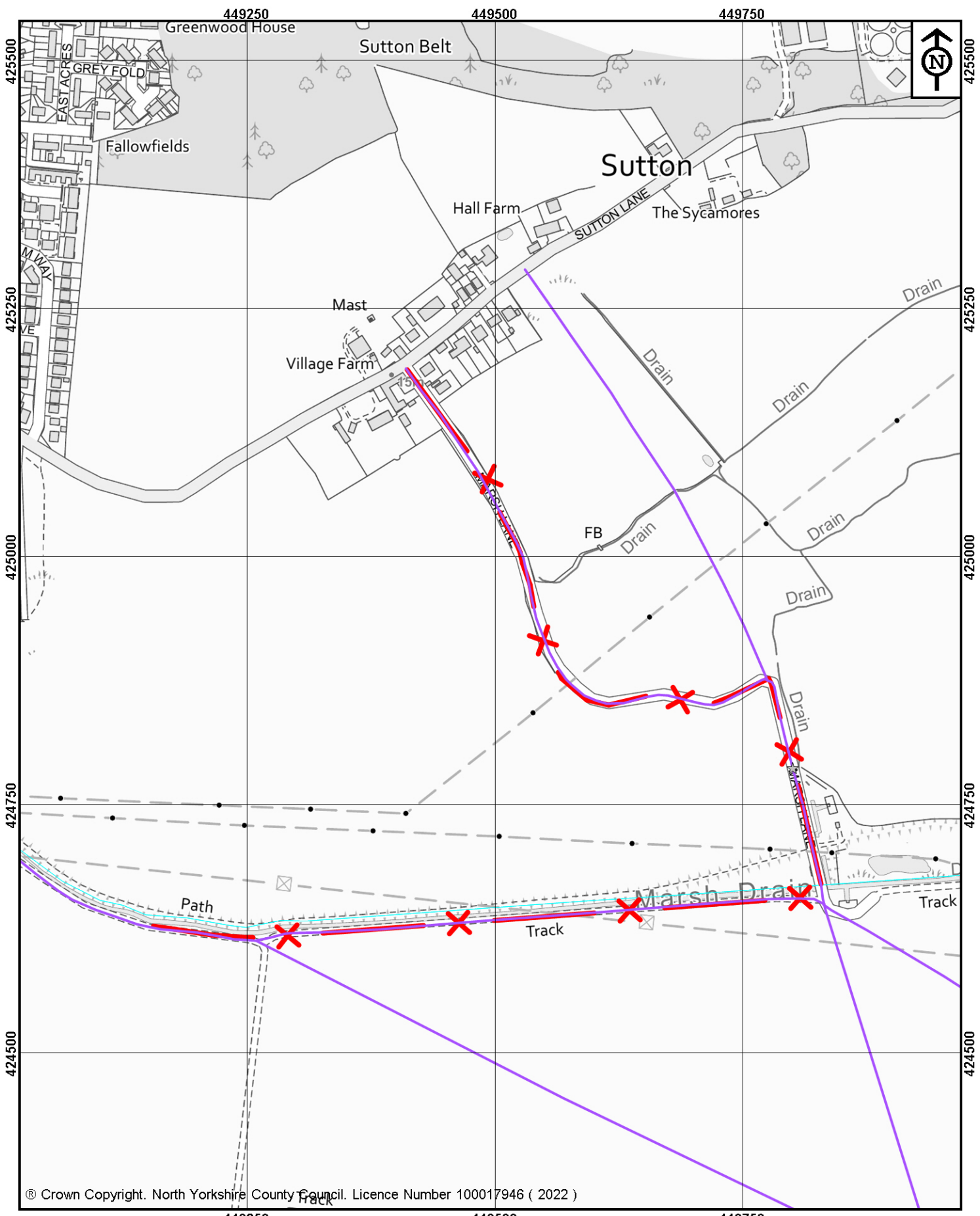
North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths No 35.16/2/2 and 35.16/2/1 Byrum cum Sutton and 35.13/11/3 and 35/13/11/2 Brotherton in the Parish of Selby, between grid reference SE49412519 and SE49152463 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 8th April 2022 and 7th October 2022 due to earthworks to flood embankment and culvert repairs.

The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
