Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

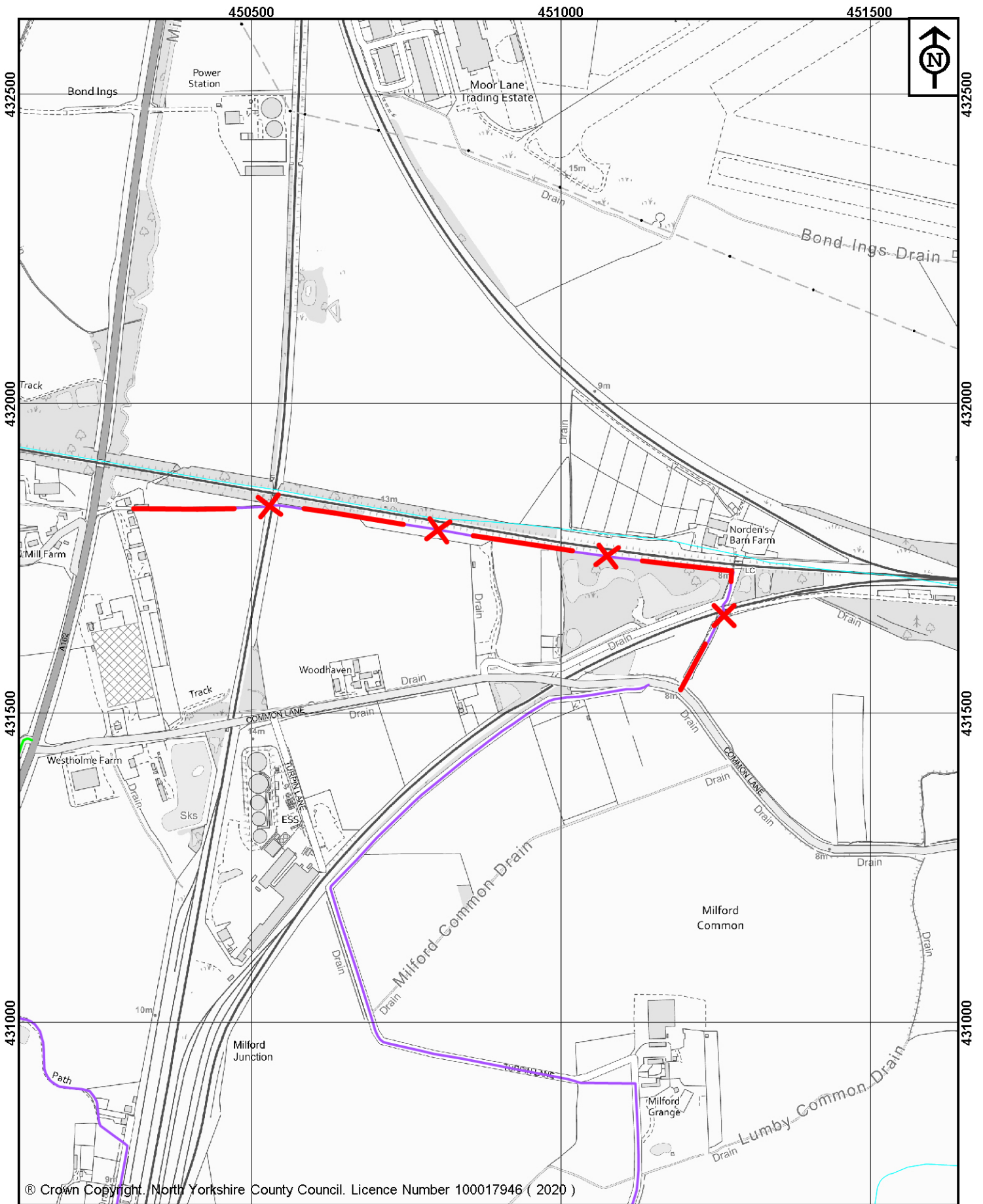
North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 35.59/5/1, South Milford, Selby, between grid reference SE5030 3182 and SE5119 3153 for a temporary period of six months (subject to access to premises) between 24 September 2020 and 2 March 2021 due to public safety pending closure of dangerous rail crossing. This Order follows a closure under Emergency Notice No 213 which commenced 3 September 2020.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
