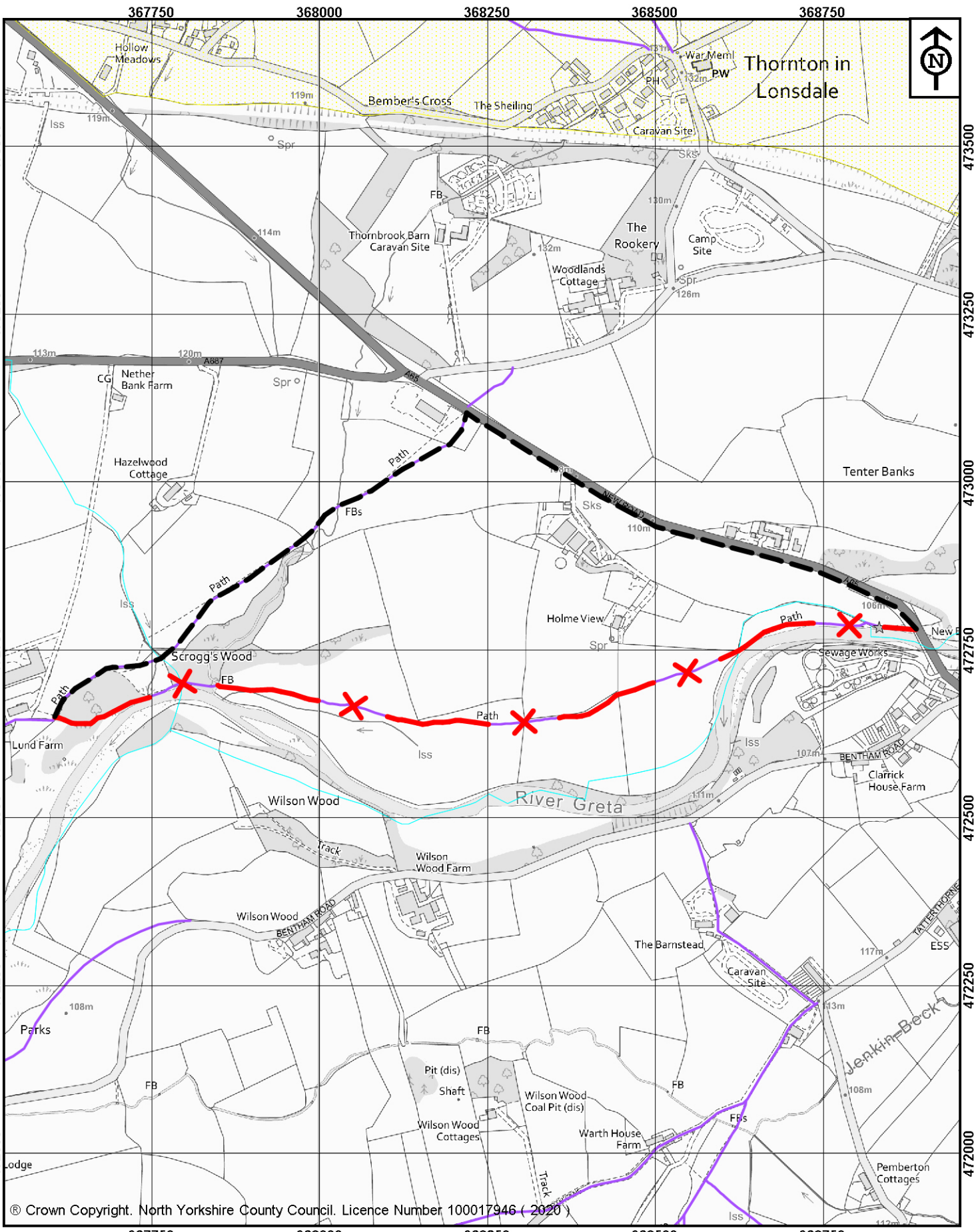
Notice is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpaths 05.42/24/1 & 05.42/18/1, Thornton In Lonsdale and 05.26/30/1, Ingleton and 05.9/11/1, Burton In Lonsdale, between grid references SD68887278 and SD67607264, due to erosion resulting in the route not being safe for the public has been continued in force for a further twelve months until 18th May 2022 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs. An alternative route will be signed on site.
