

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) 05.5/7/1, BENTHAM, CRAVEN
ORDER 2018 NO 273
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the 05.5/7/1, Bentham, Craven, between grid reference SD64536943 and SD64566930 for a temporary period of six months (subject to access to premises) between 12th July 2018 and 11th January 2019 due to (public safety during grit blasting works on the railway bridge).

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.

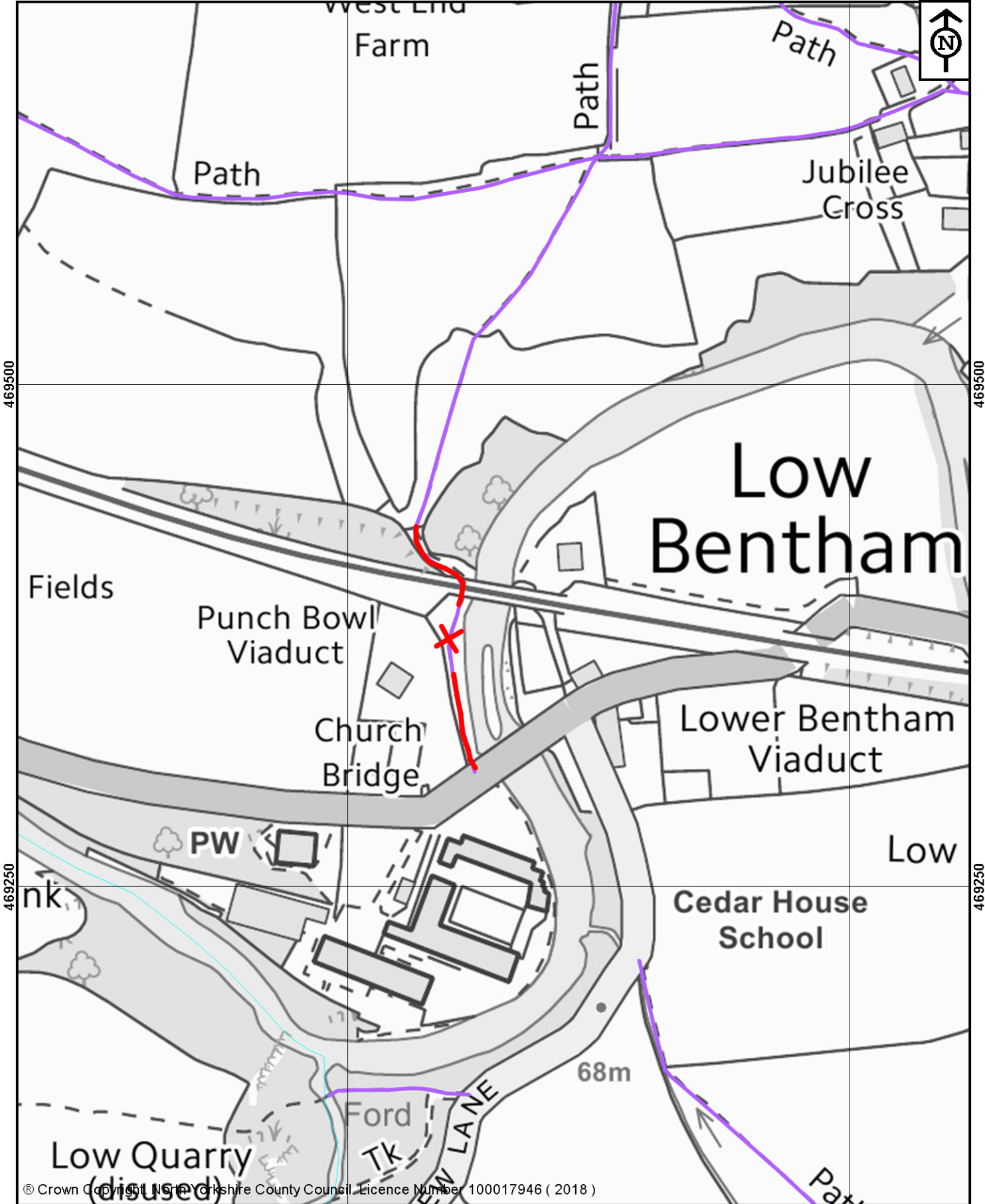
