Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

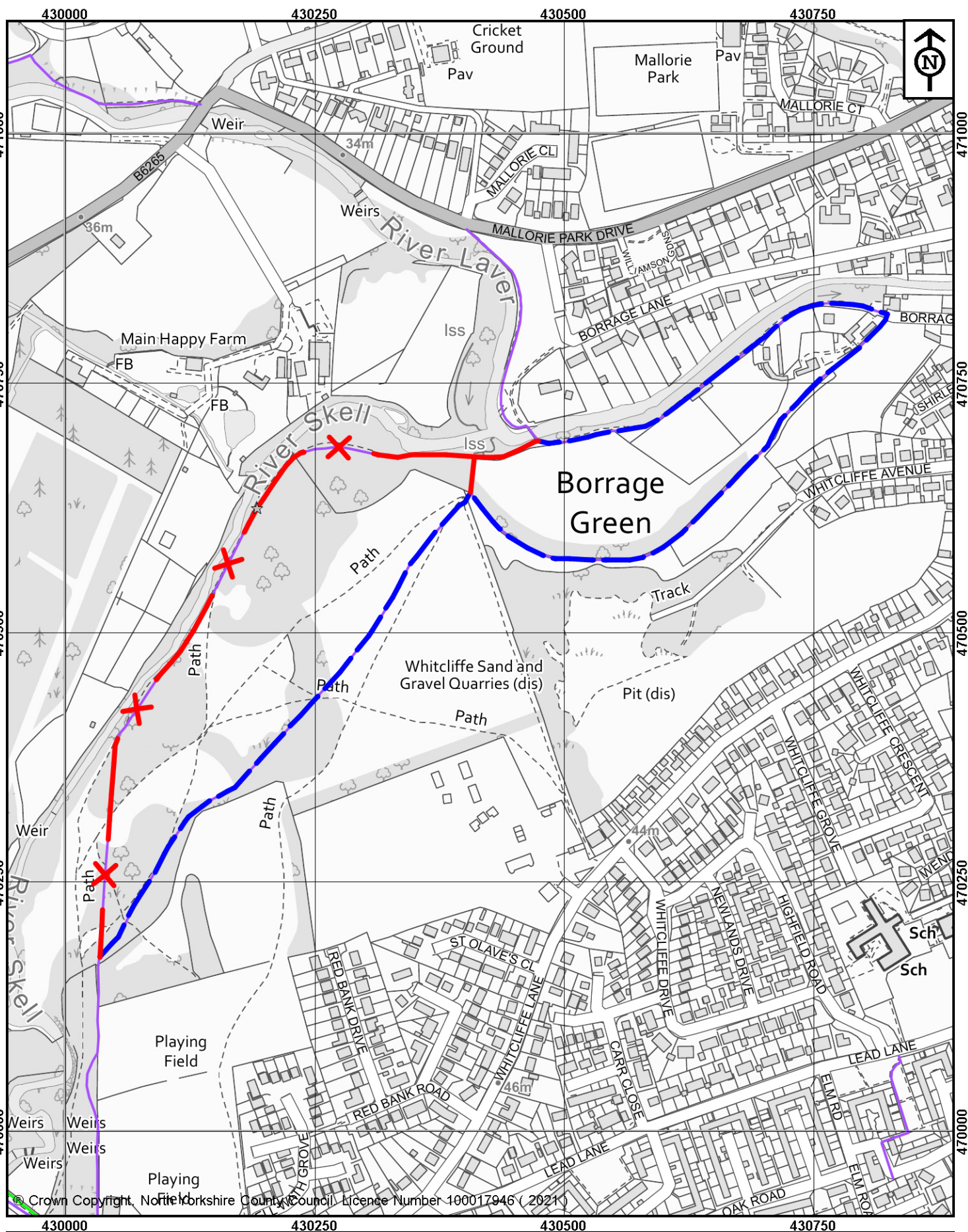
North Yorkshire County Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths 15.112/11/3, 15.112/11/2 & 15.112/12/2, Ripon between grid reference SE30037017 and SE30477069 for a temporary period of six months (subject to access to premises) between 30th July 2021 and 29th January 2022 due to the re-enforcement of the Skell river bank.


The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
