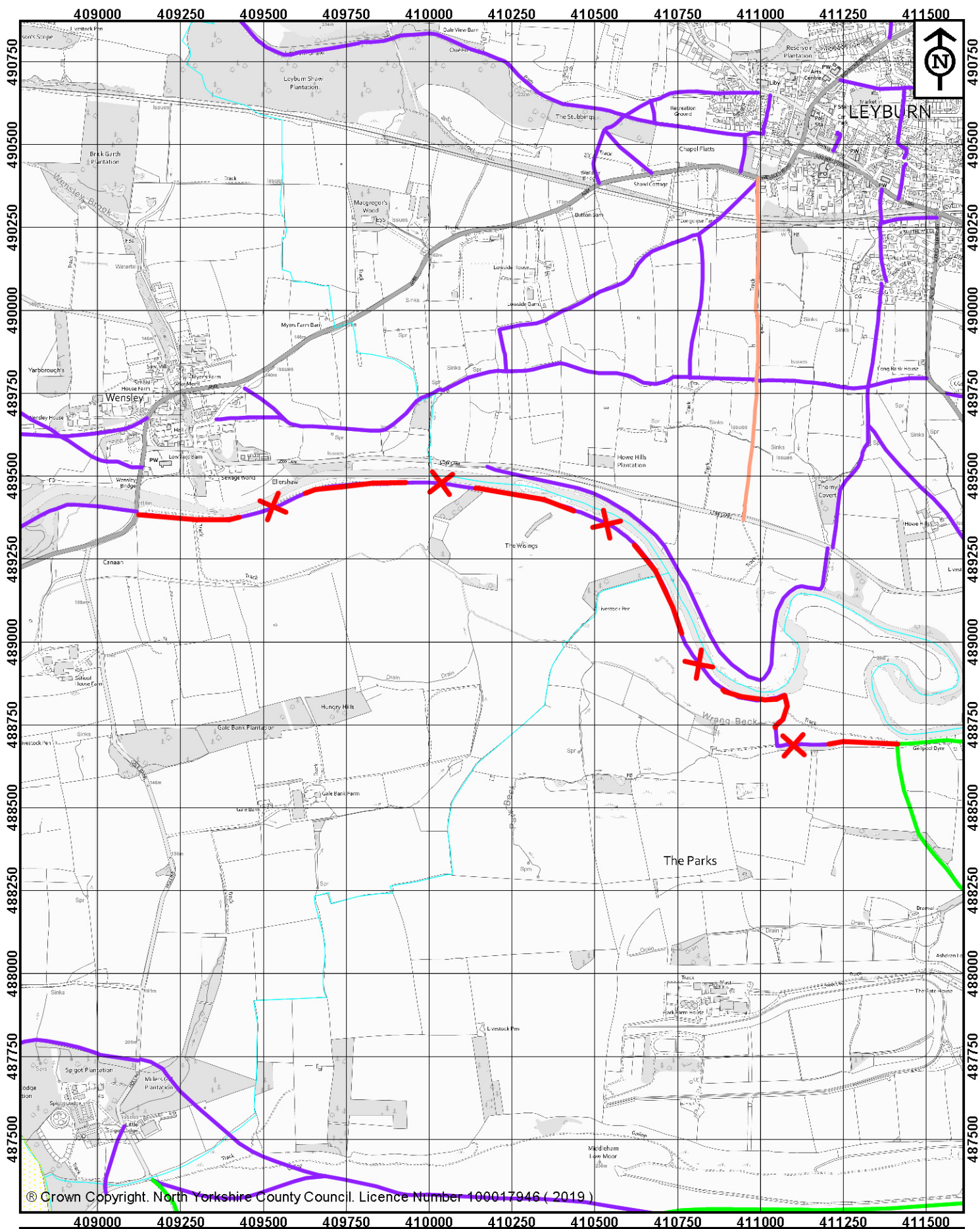
NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpaths 20.70/15/1 Wensley & 20.45/11/1 Middleham between grid reference SE09128938 and SE11418869 due to river bank erosion and health and safety concerns has been continued in force for a further 12 months until 15th January 2023 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs.
