ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(2b) (AS AMENDED)

The North Yorkshire Council hereby gives notice that from 7th September 2023 until 28th September 2023 inclusive, no pedestrian shall proceed along Public Footpaths 25.50/2/1, Howsham and 25.82/7/1, Scrayingham, between grid reference SE73256252 and SE73336035, due to a bridge that has been removed and the beck cannot be crossed safely until a replacement is installed.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs.

Access for pedestrians to premises will be maintained at all times.

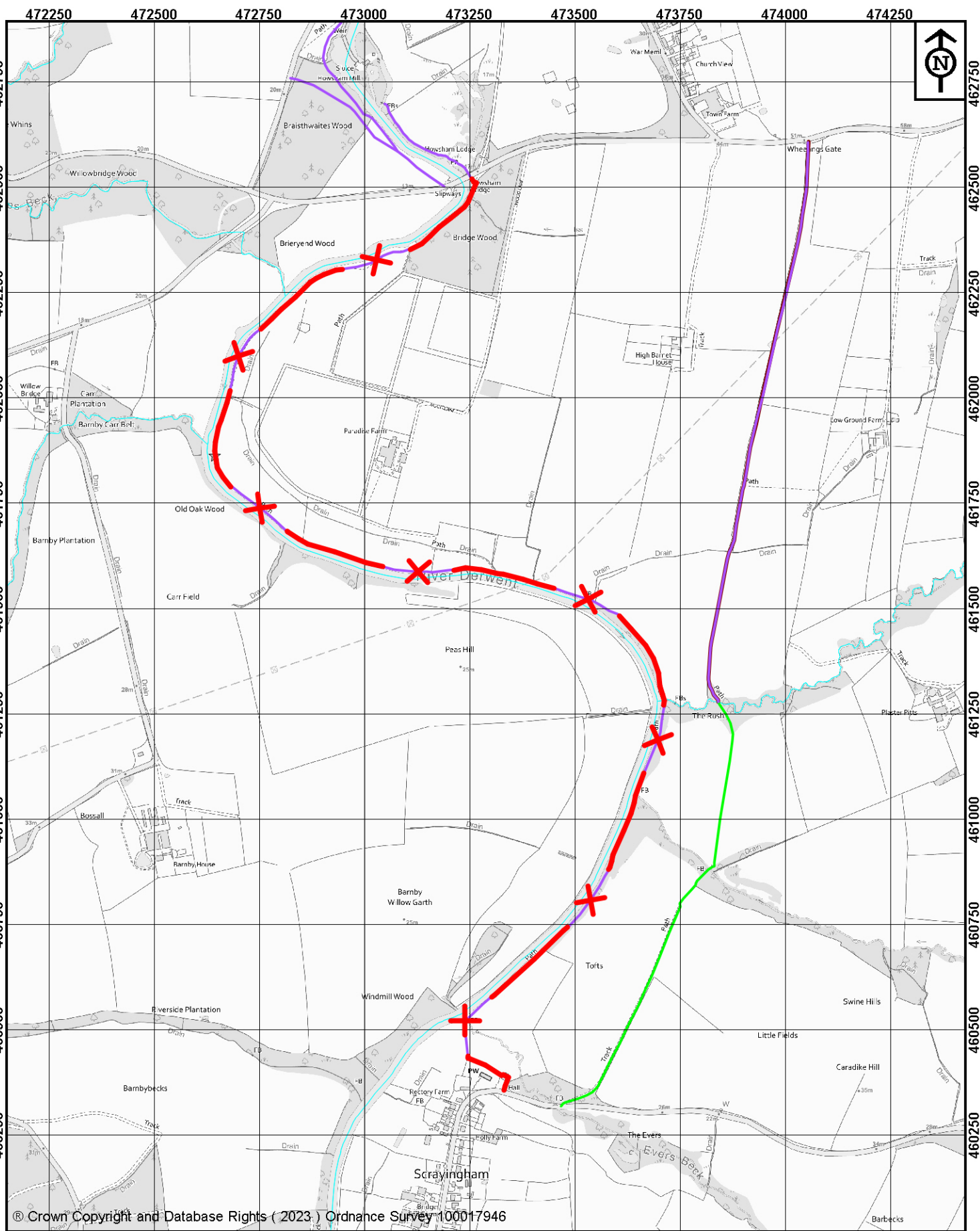
