

Notice of Confirmation of a Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order, Highways Act 1980 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 North Yorkshire County Council, Footpath 30.26/007 (part) Raws Farm, Goldsborough, Lythe, Diversion Order 2019

On 04/03/2019, North Yorkshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the confirmed Order is to divert the public footpath described below and modify The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the North York Moors National Park accordingly. Footpath 30.26/007 starting at the road side at GR NZ 8354 1470 proceeding in a north north easterly direction then north north westerly direction to GR NZ 8346 1517 will be diverted onto a new line starting at GR NZ 8349 1473 running over a culvert then proceeding in a north north easterly direction then north westerly direction through a kissing gate at GR NZ 8352 1488, then proceeding in a north north westerly direction to GR NZ 8346 1517. A copy of the confirmed Order and order map may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Whitby Community library, Windsor Terrace, Whitby until 26/04/19. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from Waste & Countryside Services, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2.00, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices. The Order comes into force on 03/05/2019, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 15/03/19 make an application to the High Court.
