ORDER 2022 NO 291
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpath 35.31/1/2, Grimston, between grid reference SE49214234 and SE50464168 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 12th September 2022 and 11th March 2023 to allow the surface to recover following repairs to the river bank.


The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
