Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

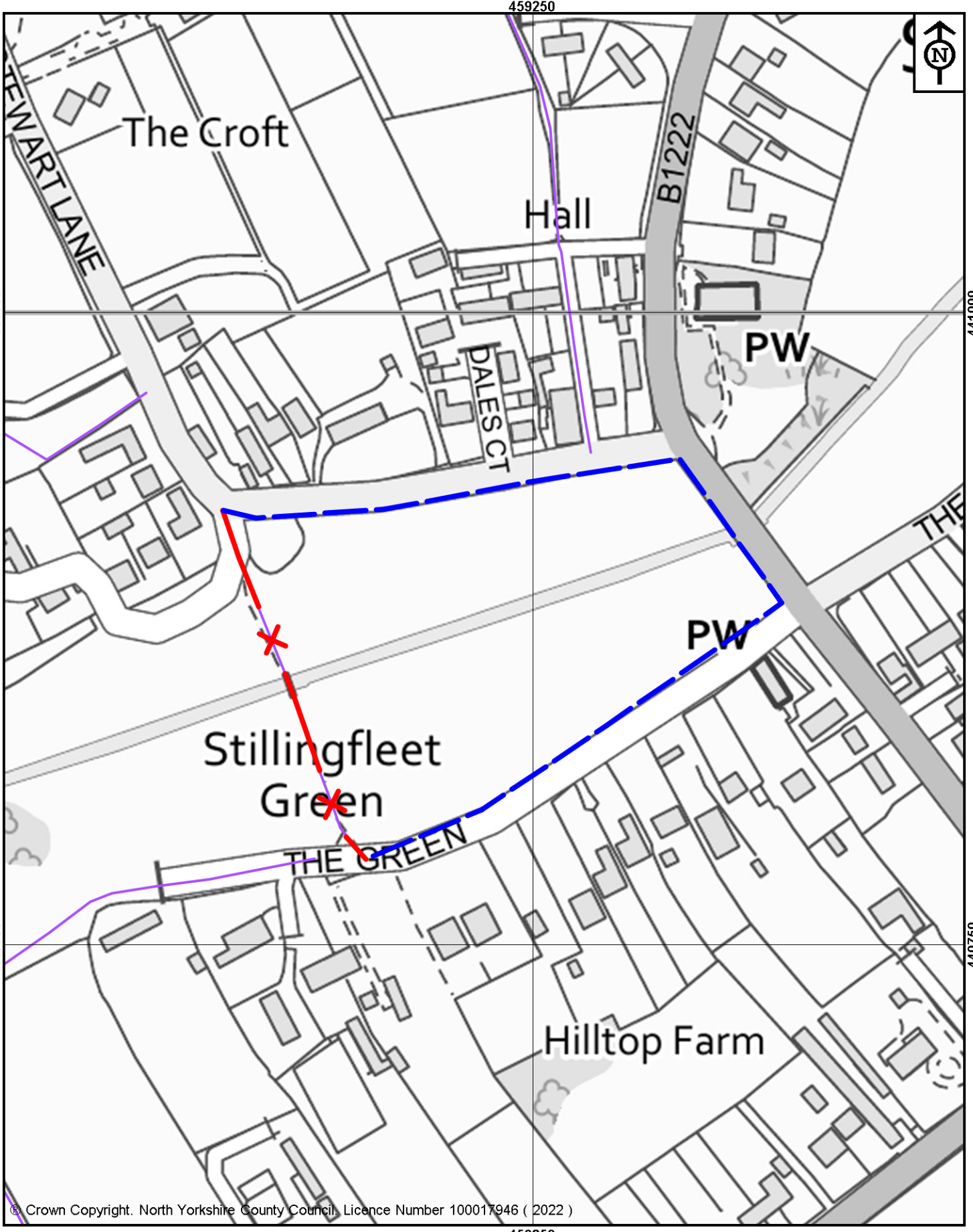
North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 35.62/3/1 Stillingfleet, between grid reference SE59124092 and SE59184078 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 7th November 2022 and 16th April 2023 due to a rotten bridge. This Order follows a closure under Emergency Notice No 343 which commenced on 17th October 2022.

The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
