Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpaths 35.64/2/2 & 35.64/16/2, Tadcaster and 35.31/5/1, 35.31/2/1 & 35.31/1/1 Grimston, between grid reference SE48974317 and SE49214235 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 12th September 2022 and 11th March 2023 to allow the surface to recover following repairs to the river bank.


The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
