Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpaths 35.64/2/2 & 35.64/16/2, Tadcaster and 35.31/5/1, 35.31/2/1 & 35.31/1/1 Grimston, between grid reference SE48974317 and SE49214235 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and 11<sup>th</sup> March 2023 to allow the surface to recover following repairs to the river bank.

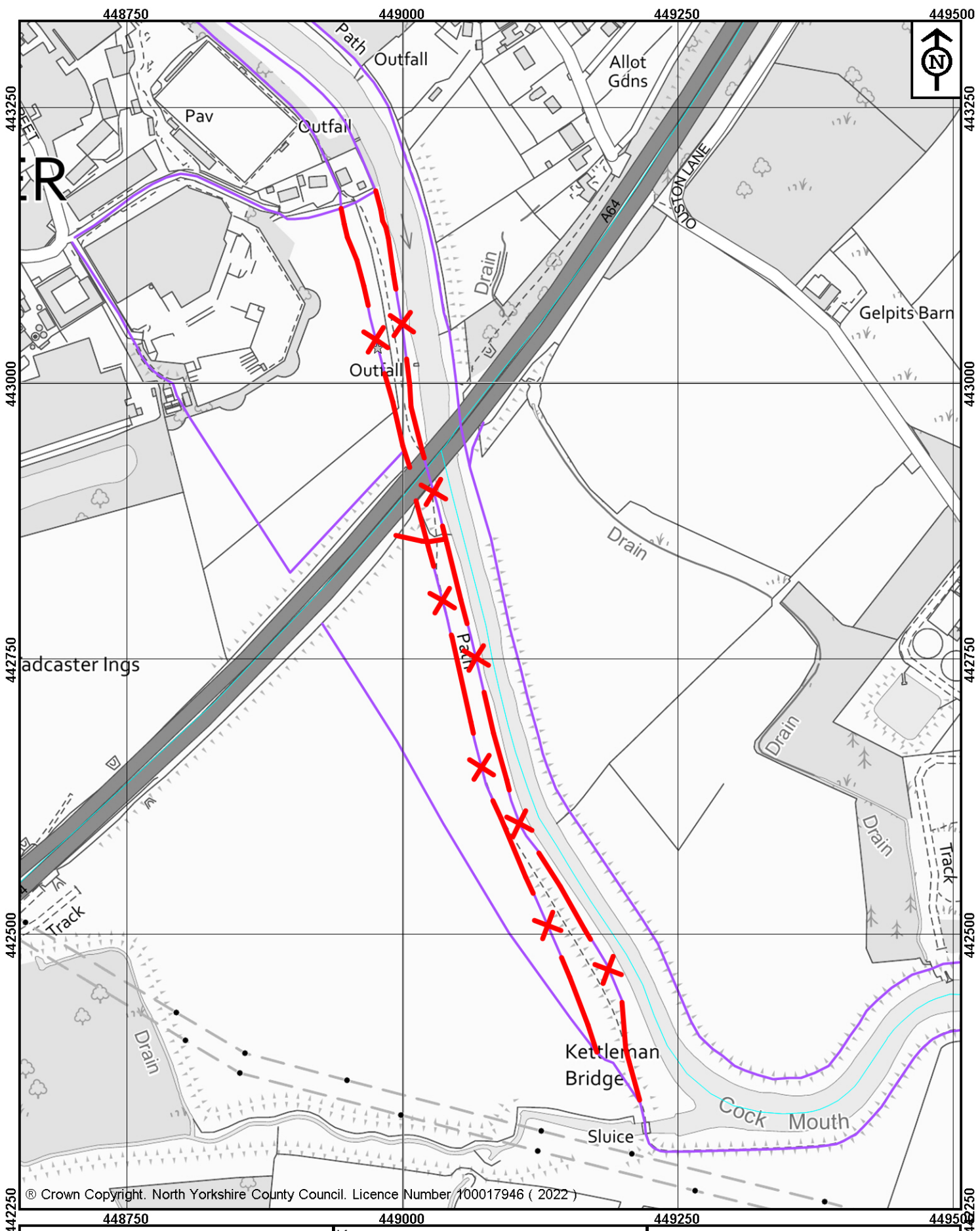
The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
