NOTICE OF MAKING OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 25.70/16, HALL FARM, NORTON-ON-DERWENT,
DIVERSION ORDER 2022

The above Order, made on 9.9.2022, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the Public Footpath described below.

From GR SE7813 6969 in a grass pasture at Hall Farm, and running south west to GR SE7797 6944, will be diverted onto a new line from GR SE7813 6969 and running south south east, along a fence-line to GR SE7815 6957, through a pedestrian gate and then running west to GR SE7797 6944. Total distance of approximately 343 metres.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Malton Library, St Michael St, Malton, North Yorkshire until 7.12.2022. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from Travel, Environmental & Countryside Services, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2, or can be downloaded free from our website <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices>.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Claire Phillips, Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire County Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire DL7 8AD not later than 7.12.2022. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Yorkshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 25.70/16, HALL FARM, NORTON-ON-DERWENT, DIVERSION ORDER 2022

This Order is made by North Yorkshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner(s) of the land crossed by the Public Footpath described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Path(s) should be diverted.

Mrs L Barnard, Hall Farm, Welham, Malton, YO17 9QF has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the Path(s) into a fit condition for use by the public.

Ryedale District Council and Norton-on-Derwent Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Hall Farm, Welham, Norton-on-Derwent and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path or way, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be the Public Footpath over the land situated at Hall Farm, Welham, Norton-on-Derwent described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The following works shall be carried out by the applicant in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: Supply and install Pedestrian Gate at Point C.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

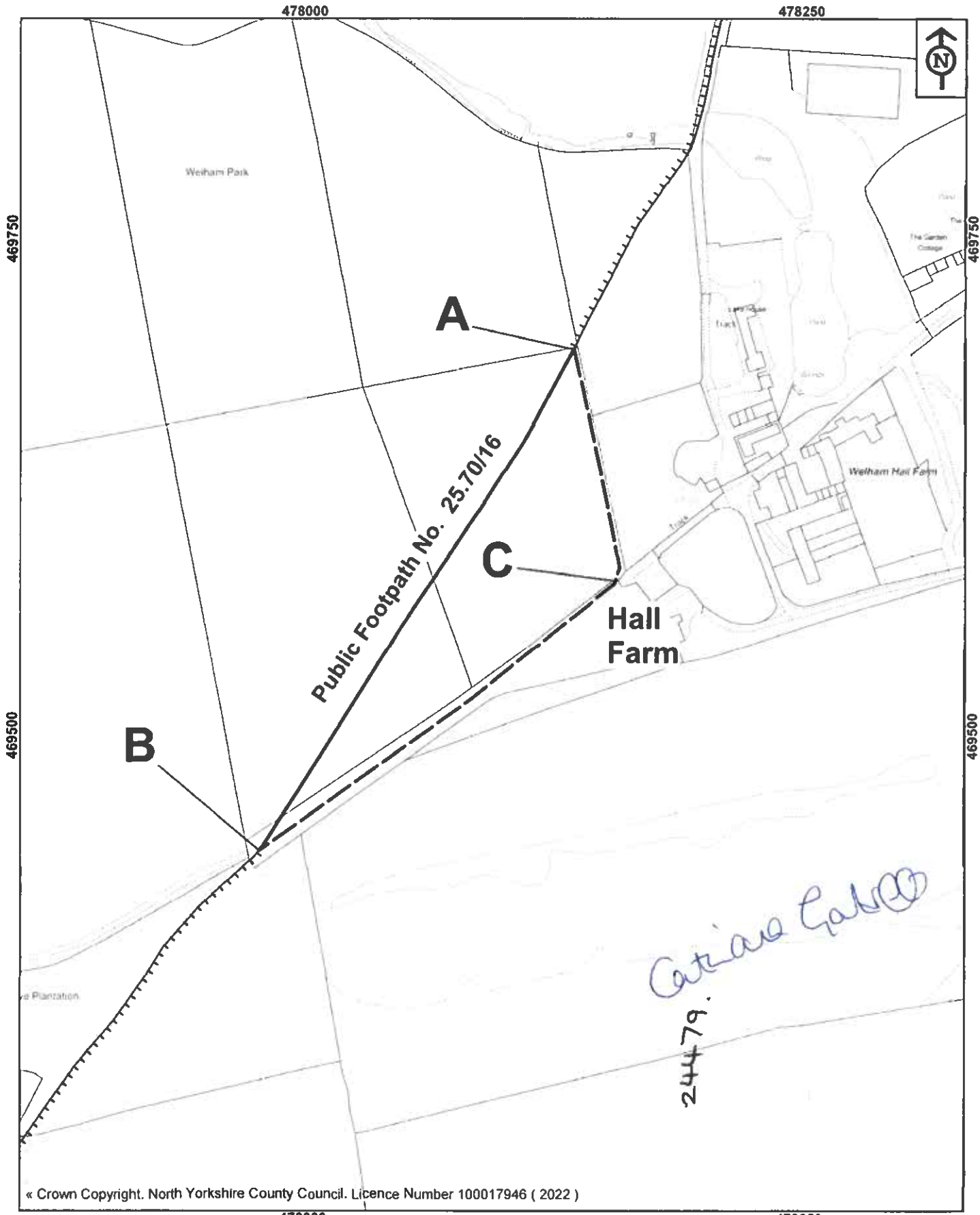

Starting at Grid Reference 47813 46969 (Point A), to the west of a stile, in the corner of a grass pasture and running south south east, along a fence-line for approximately 119 metres to a pedestrian gate at Grid Reference 47815 46957 (Point C), and then running south west, through a narrow grass pasture, for approximately 224 metres to Grid Reference 47797 46944 (Point B), just north east of a stile.
