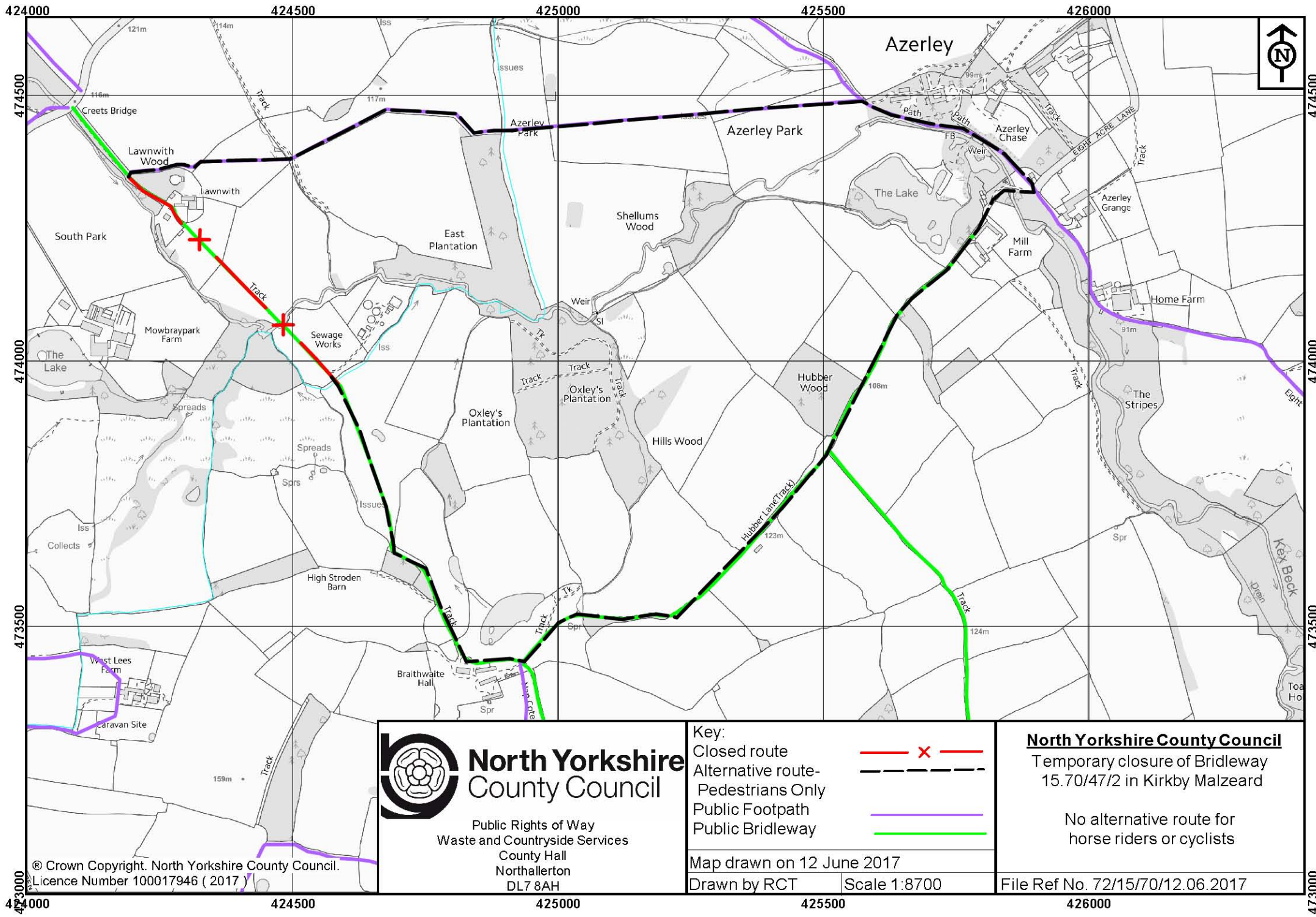

(PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY 15.70/47/2 KIRKBY MALZEARD)
ORDER 2017 NO 248
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire County Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using Public Bridleway 15.70/47/2 Kirkby Malzeard in the District of Harrogate for a temporary period of six months (subject to access to premises) between 3rd July 2017 and 2nd January 2018 because of works required to repair the bridge. The closure period will only apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.
